

# **Consultation request for the determination of the novel food status under Article 4 (2) of Regulation (EU) 2015/2283 on novel foods**

## **Recipient Member State**

Norway, the Norwegian Food Safety Authority

## **Name and description of the food in question**

The request concerns bone powder (CalGo®), produced from the bones of Atlantic salmon (*Salmo salar*). The bones are milled into bone powder, which consists of calcium >19% and phosphorus >9% in the form of calcium hydroxyapatite, and collagen protein 25-37%.

The intended use is to provide supplemental calcium in the form of calcium hydroxyapatite as well as phosphorus and protein.

## **Status**

Not novel

## **Reasons statement**

Competent authorities of the EU Member States and the European Commission were consulted.

Based on the available information, there is evidence that bone powder produced from the bones of Atlantic salmon (*Salmo salar*) has been used for human consumption to a significant degree within the European Union/European Economic Area before 15 May 1997.
