




Timeline of the survey of OCR Questionnaire(Art.50)






Number of respondents by Member State








Type of commodities represented by the different production groups




Closure of approved places of destination for the import of plants






Efficiency of the procedures for carrying out controls at controls points








Impact of the new OCR on the costs and time needed to perform physical checks on plants (at the BCPs)





Impact on the total costs of controls after the introduction of the new OCR


