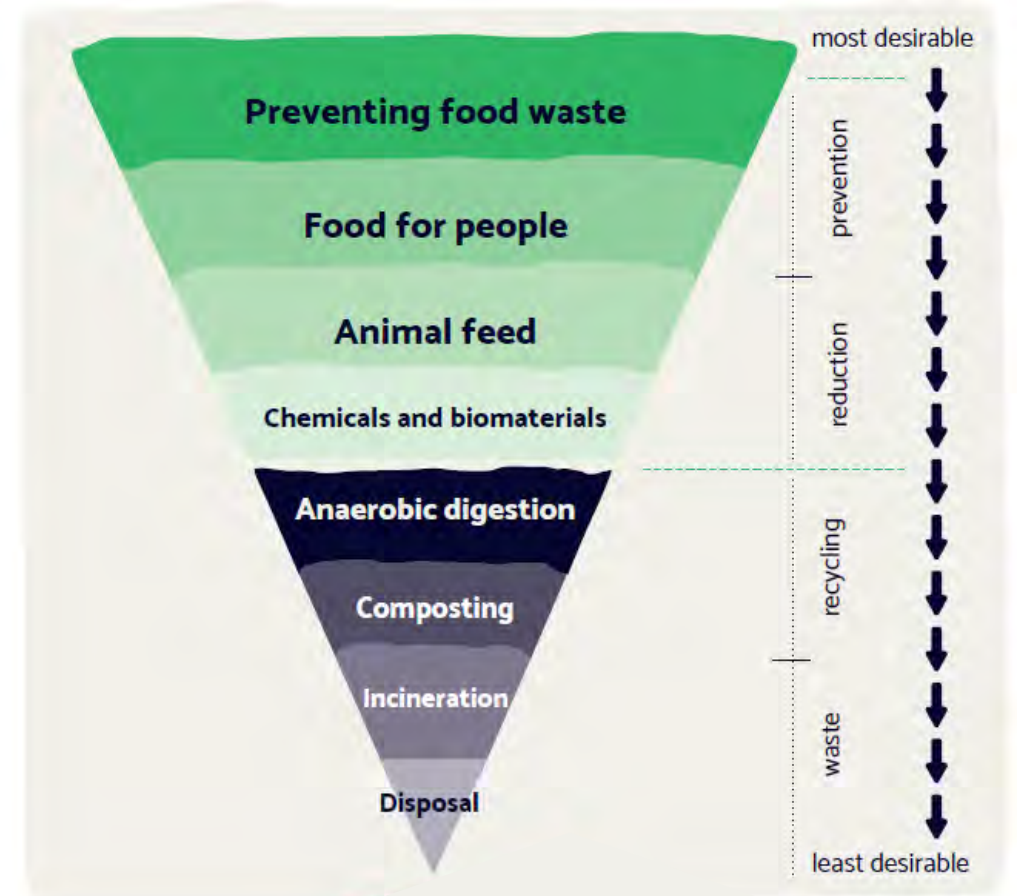
- 2 Meetings held on 25 May 2023 and 25 October 2023

Voluntary Agreements report – state of play

- Deliverable – Report on Voluntary Agreements in the EU to be adopted by the Platform in Q1 2024
- Based on replies from a questionnaire sent 22 November 2022, and further consultations with contributors
- Last review by contributors – deadline 9 November 2023
- Examples of VAs in Member States and Norway and UK and other forms of collaborations between stakeholders
- Living document

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- Experience from Netherlands
Valorisation of co-products and “former” foodstuffs for animal feed.
- Partnership models have scaling potential such as Kipster, JEGG future farming, Oranjehoen and Zonvarken.

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Meeting on 25 October – key take aways:

- **Key theme “food waste in the bioeconomy”**
- Competition for residual biomass flows could drive food waste generation / obstruct circularity
- Caution needed with biomethane stimulation policies
