March/April 2018 Preparation of the reporting template

May-July 2018 Collection of information on food waste initiatives through the reporting template

▼ October 2018 Workshop with the sub-group members, and the 'best practices' criteria

November 2018 Validation of the criteria by the sub-group and the EU Platform on Food Losses and Food Waste



Indicative planning (2)

January 2019 Analysis of collected food waste initiatives and their relevant information

March 2019 Workshop with the sub-group 'action and implementation' on the draft recommendations based on the rapporteurs proposals

May/June 2019 Presentation and adoption of the recommendations in the Platform meeting
