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Legal context – emergency measures (before the entry into force of Reg. (EU) 652/2014)

LEGAL BASIS

Council Decision 2009/470/EC on expenditure in the veterinary field

Chapter II – Section 2 (Articles 3-13)

+

Commission Regulation (EC) No 349/2005 laying down rules on the Community financing of emergency measures and of the campaign to combat certain animal diseases under Council Decision 90/424/EEC based on Council Regulation (EC) No 1258/1999 on the financing of the CAP (repealed by Council Regulation (EC) No 1290/2005)

- •Cost claim from Member States
- Commission Decision: final eligible amounts (comitology)



Legal context – emergency measures (under Reg. (EU) 652/2014, in force since 30 June 2014)

LEGAL BASIS

Title II - Chapter I - Section 1 + Annex I

Eligible measures (Article 6) + Eligible costs (Article 8) + Eligible animal diseases **Alignment with regime of GRANTS (Title VI of Financial Regulation)**

! Council Decision 2009/470/EC → REPEALED:

Reg. (EU) 652/2014 is the NEW single legal basis for funding

! Commission Regulation (EC) No 349/2005 → OBSOLETE:

Food and feed budget lines not part of AGRI budget (Heading II) any longer NOW part Heading III (Security and citizenship)





New Procedures for emergency measures *Flowchart (1)*

T 1
REQUEST

(Target, 1 month) After confirmation of disease, the MS requests financial support with preliminary information on categories of animal and products.

T 2 FORECAST

(Target, 3 months)

The MS informs the COMM on:

- the estimated costs for the compensation (animals and products) the estimated operational costs update on compensation and operational costs every 2 months - if applicable, MS requests also exceptional costs, pursuant to Article 8.1(h) of the Financial Regulation 652/2014. with appropriate justification.

T 3 FINANCING DECISION

(Target, 2 months after T2) The COMM adopts a <u>financing decision</u>* by an implementing act: - defining the financing conditions;

 listing the eligible costs and rates;

 fixing a EU maximum potential contribution
 possible granting of advance payment.

Note

The financing decision will be complemented by a <u>grant decision</u> adopted by the AOSD

T 4

PAYMENT APPLICATION

(Target, 4 months after the last outbreak, unless other provisions set up by financing Decision)

The MS submits:

 the request for payment for the eligible costs incurred
 the technical and the financial reports.
 <u>Note</u>
 Format of submission and reports to be fixed by <u>implementing</u> <u>decision</u>



New Procedures for emergency measures *Flowchart (2)*

Т5

APPLICATION ASSESSMENT

The COMM assesses:

the eligibility of the payment application by desk controls. On
request only, additional supporting documents if needed ;
considers the possibility of
organising ex ante onthe-spot checks
(especially if the costs are above 2mio).

T 6

VALIDATION OF EXPENDITURE

The COMM determines the eligible costs and informs the MS about accepted costs.

Т7

COMMITMENT AND PAYMENT

(Target, no later than 3 months after T4)

The COMM makes the <u>budgetary commitments</u> and reimburses the MS by payments (conf. Art. 8.3).

Financing Decision for emergency measures (SANCO/12153/2014)

Based on Art. 36(4) of Regulation (EU) No 652/2014

Adoption:

comitology

•within five months after confirmation / two months after submission of efile with information from the MS to the Commission

Contents:

- •maximum amount (for a given disease, in a given MS, in a given year)
- reimbursement rate
- •eligible costs
- •flexibility clause



Procedures for submissions, reports and payments for emergency measures (SANCO/12248/2014)

•Based on Art. 36(5) of Regulation (EU) No 652/2014

•Horizontal decision replacing procedural aspects provided in Commission Regulation (EC) No 349/2005

Main document

•Information flow: from confirmation to payment

Annexes

- •I: template of e-file for request of financial support + information
- •II: template of e-file for final financial report
- •III: template of e-file for payments requests with detailed info on eligible costs made and paid
- •IV: (under elaboration) technical report

 Standard provisions and principles for all Commission grant decisions e.g. no-profit rule, responsibility of the beneficiary, *force majeure*, suspension of payment, suspension of the grant, assessments, checks and audits, etc.

•II: Estimated budget

individual amounts for eligible direct costs + 7% overhead

- •III: Description of the action
- •IV: Financial information
