




Current situation in poultry

- Since the mid-April no outbreaks in the EU in poultry
- 08/04/19: last outbreak in Bulgaria in a commercial holding in Plovdiv region
- all 6 outbreaks in **Bulgaria** since December 2018 were caused by the HPAI **subtype H5N8**
- No virus detection in wild birds in BG or any other MS

• No findings since December 2018

LPAI H5 in captive birds


- 1 outbreak in The Netherlands in December 2018
- 1 outbreak in Germany in April 2019

Non-notifiable H3N1 in Belgium

- Since January H3N1
- Mid-May in total 36 cases of non H5/H7, from which 31 confirmed as H3 (6 confirmed as H3N1)
- Breeders, laying hens, turkeys
- In some cases high mortality and severe drop in egg production
