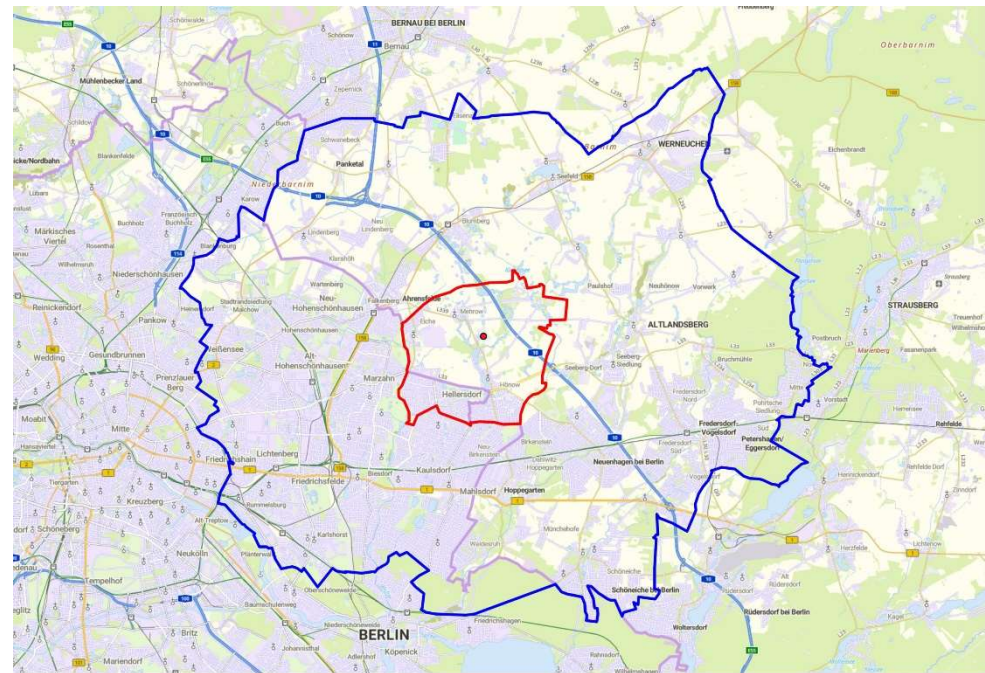

FMD in DEU
Brandenburg (BB)
– 1st case since 1988



FMD in water buffalo in Märkisch Oderland district (MOL), BB

- 1st case since 1988 on January 10th, 2025 (ADIS DE-FMD-2025-00001)
- Herd of 14, three dead
- Extensive keeping in nature reserve close to Berlin, only self produced feed (hey)
- Stamping out and safe disposal
- Implementing protection and surveillance zone (two neighbouring districts within 10km surveillance zone affected - Barnim and Berlin- Marzahn/Hellersdorf)
- Serotype O, exchange with Pirbright



FMD measures in BB and Berlin

- Stamping out and safe disposal in 1km zone and one contact establishment
- 72h stand still in all of BB for cloven-hoofed animals – will be extended 48h
- FLI for epidemiological investigation on the spot
- Epidemiological investigations including contact establishments (route of practitioner and rendering lorry)

FMD measures in BB

- Sampling all establishments within RZ and contacts ongoing – so far only negative results
- Immediate, close and regular exchange with Bundesländer and stakeholder
- Publicly available information and press releases – raising

FMD additional measures

- Closing of Berlin Zoo and Tierpark
- No assembling of cloven-hoofed animals on International Green Week in Berlin (West)
- No hunting in RZ, sampling of wild cloven-hoofed animals
