Legal base

- Commission Decision of 30 May 2016 establishing horizontal rules on the creation and operation of Commission Expert Groups (so-called horizontal rules) => Article 14
- Commission Decision of 24 January 2017 establishing the Commission Expert Group 'Platform on Animal Welfare' => Article 8







Scope of sub-groups

- Sub-groups are set up <u>for the purpose of examining specific questions.</u>
- Sub-groups shall operate <u>in compliance with the</u> <u>horizontal rules.</u>
- Mandate is defined by the Commission on the basis of terms of reference.
- Sub-groups are dissolved as soon as their mandate is fulfilled.





Composition of sub-groups

- Selection from Platform members
- Public call for applications is needed in case of non-Platform members
- Selection process of the public call is defined in:
 - Article 5 of the Commission Decision in establishing the Platform
 - Article 10 of the horizontal rules on Expert groups





Scope

- To <u>assist and advise</u> the Commission on issues relating to EU animal welfare legislation
- To <u>facilitate</u> the exchange of information, experience and good practices in the area of animal welfare legislation
- To better <u>target</u> specific topics and
- To achieve concrete <u>results</u>

Structure and membership

- A maximum of 20 members to facilitate direct exchanges
- Balanced representation in representing <u>various</u> <u>interests groups</u>





Composition

- Member States, EEA members and international organisations: 8 seats
- Business and professional organisations: 4 seats
- Organisations from civil society: 4 seats
- Independent experts: 4 seats





Membership criteria

- Members should have the <u>relevant expertise</u> and <u>experience on the objectives of the sub</u> group: e.g. different species and types of transport
- Members should be committed to provide concrete contributions
- Member States should have significant trade of live animals on long journey
