

#### Current situation





- 89 ASF cases in wild boars (the last one on 1st April)
- o ASF outbreaks in domestic pigs
- in 2017 in Poland




Application concerning:

the województwo **podlaskie** (Podlaskie Region) → **sokólski** powiat (Sokółka District) → the gminy (communes) of: **Dąbrowa Białostocka, Janów, Nowy Dwór, Sidra, Suchowola** and **Korycin.** 

In March 2017 Poland applied for lifting the Part II and for re-inclusion of area above-mentioned into Part I of the Annex to the Commission Implementing Decision 2014/709/EU.























- ✓ Recital (8) of the Decision 2014/709/EU (in areas listed in Part II the presence of ASF occurs in the wild boar population)
- ✓ Commission working document no. SANTE/7112/2015 on principles and criteria for geographically defining ASF regionalization (there have been no ASF cases in wild boar during the past 12 months):
- No ASF cases in wild boars on the area of the communes of Dąbrowa Białostocka, Janów, Nowy Dwór, Suchowola and Korycin
- the latest (and only one) ASF case in wild boar in the commune of Sidra - on 26 November 2015



- ✓ The generally favourable epidemiological situation is an inidicator that Poland meets the criteria for lifting Part II zone
- ✓ There are **other**, **additional circumstances** that substantiate the appliacation



### **ASF Surveillance - pigs**

In areas listed in Part II samples are collected from pigs:

- ✓ in case of suspicion of the occurrence of ASF
- ✓ sick or dead pigs, for which infection with ASF virus cannot be excluded (from dead pigs, showing atypical or suspicious clinical symptoms)
- ✓ as well as from pigs slaughtered for the production of meat intended for personal use in case of suspicion
- ✓ No of samples taken from pigs (live and dead) tested between 1<sup>st</sup> January 2016 and 26<sup>th</sup> February 2017 → **8 314 samples**

#### ASF Surveillance – wild boar

In areas listed in Part II samples are collected from:

- ✓ every dead wild boar (including also animals killed during road accidents)
- ✓ every shot wild boar
- ✓ No of wild boars tested:

### Additionally on the Sokółka District:

- ✓ Shooting of wild boars has been intensified
- ✓ Sanitary shooting of wild boars is carried out
- ✓ No of wild boars shot:

1 January 2016 – 24 February 2017 → 591 wild boars



wild boar population in March 2015 – app. 1 208 wild boars wild boar population in March 2016 – app. 926 wild boars at the end of October 2016 – app. 300-400 wild boars



✓ the additional financial incentives for the hunters and
forest service employees for reporting the dead wild
boars throughout the entire territory of Part II and Part
III → currently app. EUR 25
