- CID 2021/788 adopted on 12 May 2021
- Four follow-up reports by Latvia and Poland



Poland – update on 7/2021 and 9/2021

7/2021

- located in voivodeship wielkopolskie, powiat Krotoszyn.
- No increased mink mortality reported
- The first 90 swabs from animals were collected: no SARS-CoV-2 genetic material was found
- Outbreak was closed

• 9/2021

- located in voivodeship podlaskie, powiat Białystok.
- No mortality reported
- Twice, the first 90 swabs from animals were collected: no SARS-CoV-2 genetic material was found
- Outbreak was closed

Latvia – update on outbreak Confirmed on 10/04/2021

- The number of minks in the affected farm has been reduced to 87 504 breeding animals
- In the priod 1st December 2021 3rd March 2022 (via enhanced passive surveillance) only 8 PCR positive minks were detected. The last SARS-CoV-2 virus positive result was detected on 11th of February
- The restrictions for the farm have been lifted as of 4th March 2022
- National measures for mink farms include passive surveillance, biosecurity and obligation to report increased mortality or morbidity
