Reporting on:

- SARS-CoV-2 in minks and other animals of the family *Mustelidae* and in raccoon dogs
- CID 2021/788 adopted on 12 May 2021
- New outbreak reported by Poland



Poland

- 1 new SARS-CoV-2 outbreaks in minks (57 818 minks)
- 2022/2 located in voivodeship Wielkopolskie (Kolonia Obory)
- Control measures include:
 - Isolation, movement restrictions and observation,
 - official supervision of animal by-products, feed, bedding,
 - cleaning and disinfection,
 - regionalization (increased vet. surveillance in a 10 km radius)
 - no treatment of affected animals





Poland

- 2022/2 confirmed by RT-PCR on 14.07.2022
- Up to 30.8.2022 no increased morbidity nor mortality
- Communication and coordination among animal health and public health authorities
 11 employees were tested for SARS-CoV-2 with negative results
