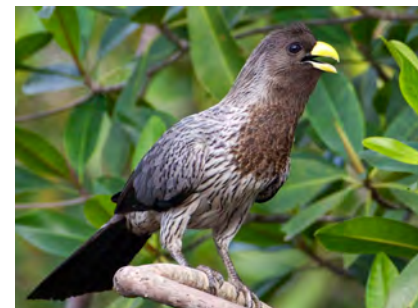


ND in illegally moved birds

Specific information for the outbreak:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - illegal import - non poultry (captive birds): in particular Passeriformes - Estrildidae (Frachtfinken) - 12 different species - all birds in quarantine No movements, neither national nor intra-Union and no exports in third countries took place from that establishment in the epidemiological relevant period.

Origin of infection	Illegal movement of animals
Control measures applied	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Quarantine Stamping out Disinfection Disease notification Official disposal of carcasses, by-products and waste.

Consequences after ADIS notification

- UKR entry stop for poultry
- Multiple explanations of situation
- Lifting of entry stop only after 1 week
