- Four follow-up reports by Poland

Poland – update on previous outbreaks

- **3/2021 (voivodeship kujawsko-pomorskie)**
 - Susceptible animals:
 - 2892 – breeding minks (2642 – female, 250 – male)
 - about 10 000 young mink
 - On 01.06.2022, 60 samples were taken for laboratory tests (I testing to exclude the disease on the quarantine) with negative results.
 - On 21.06.2022 60 samples were taken for laboratory tests (II testing to exclude the disease after 20 days from I testing) with negative results.
 - **Outbreak was closed**
