

Consignment – General rules



Positive lists:

- Reg. (EU) 2019/632
- Reg. (EU) 2019/630 (exc.)
- Reg. (EU) 2019/1793
- Reg. (EU) 2019/2072



Consignment – Use of CHED

Operator

- Identification of consignment
- Destination
- Prior notification of BCP of first arrival

BCP authorities

- Outcome of checks
- Decision on the consignment
- Finalisation of CHED

Custom authorities

- Selection of customs procedure in line with the decision of the BCP
- Release for free circulation or transit procedure upon finalisation of CHED

BCP Decision – Customs procedure



Consignment – Illegal Introduction

Not presented at BCPs

Presented without CHED at customs declarations –

Different MSs

BCP at the point of entry

No BCP at the point of entry

Notification

Communication

Measures



Consignment – Use of CN codes

Exemption from BCP

Redirect by customs to BCP

Illegal entry – Art. 66(6)

Consultation with operator, customs

Present at BCP


Customs at a later stage





Articles 86-91 OCR



- Staff performing official controls to supervise the issuance by the operators or involved in the issuance
- Staff with delegated tasks related to the official attestation or to the official supervision

Delegation of tasks

Articles 28-33 OCR

Accreditation Art. 28-33 OCR

Preferred standard:

EN ISO/IEC 17020 for inspection tasks

<u>Unless</u> another standard:

- required by sectoral legislation
- corresponding better to nature
 of the delegated tasks

Accreditation Art. 34-41 OCR

EN ISO/IEC 17025
Designation of official labs

- ➤ EN ISO/IEC 17065, Certification
- ➤ EN ISO/IEC 17021-1, Audit
- > ISO 22003-1, Audit FSMS
