## Analysis of the main irregularities found during the non-discriminatory inspections and action plan in accordance with Article 27(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1/2005

## 1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAIN IRREGULARITIES FOUND DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS

For the purpose of this annual report, the following have been considered to be major deficiencies:

- 1. documentary: completion and return of the CABs, transporter authorisations and means of transport, certificate of competence, etc.
- 2. Inadequate transport practices, available spaces and watering intervals.
- 3. Transport of unfit animals: pregnant females, animals with wounds or prolapses and unable to move by themselves.

## 2. ACTION PLAN TO CORRECT THE IRREGULARITIES DESCRIBED IN POINT 1

The main measures planned by the competent authorities to correct the irregularities are as follows:

- 1. Training: courses (welfare during transport, emergency slaughter) intended for veterinary inspectors, transporters
- 2. Strengthening of controls:

places: contests, fairs, markets, assembly centres and departures of intra-Community movements

documentation: CAB and certificates of competence,

fitness for transport, bovine animals

means of long-distance transport with satellite navigation systems

3. Intensify the systems for communicating legislation governing citizens
