## Regulation (EU) 2020/2002 – notification & reporting

### REGULATIONS

#### COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING REGULATION (EU) 2020/2002

of 7 December 2020

laying down rules for the application of Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to Union notification and Union reporting of listed diseases, to formats and procedures for submission and reporting of Union surveillance programmes and of eradication programmes and for application for recognition of disease-free status, and to the computerised information system

(Text with EEA relevance)

# Regulation (EU) 2020/2002 – notification & reporting Union notification – Art 3 (1)(b)

Notification within 24h for PRIMARY outbreaks **if** the primary outbreak has been detected in the relevant **targeted animal population in a disease-free Member State or zone**:

- Infection with Brucella abortus, B. melitensis, B. suis
- Infection with Mycobacterium tuberculosis complex (M. bovis, M. caprae, M. tuberculosis) (MTBC)
- Infectious bovine rhinotracheitis/infectious pustular vulvovaginitis (IBR/IPV)
- Bovine viral diarrhoea (BVD)

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- Enzootic bovine leukosis (EBL)
- Infection with Aujeszky's disease virus (ADV)



# Regulation (EU) 2020/2002 – notification & reporting Union notification – Art 3 (1)(c)

Notification within 24h for PRIMARY outbreaks if the primary outbreak has been detected in a disease-free Member State, zone or, where relevant, compartment:

- Infection with bluetongue virus (ser. 1-24)
- Infestation with Varroa spp.
- Infestation with Echinococcus multilocularis

- Viral haemorrhagic septicaemia
- Infectious haematopoietic necrosis
- Infection with HPR deleted infectious salmon anaemia virus
- Infection with Marteilia refringens
- Infection with Bonamia exitiosa
- Infection with Bonamia ostreae
- Infection with white spot syndrome virus ('infection with WSSV')



## Regulation (EU) 2020/2002 – notification & reporting Union notification – Art 3

Notification on a <u>weekly basis</u> for SECONDARY outbreaks with a similar breakdown as for primary



## **REGULATION (EU) 2020/689**

#### COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) 2020/689

of 17 December 2019

supplementing Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards rules for surveillance, eradication programmes, and disease-free status for certain listed and emerging diseases

- Case definition (Art 9)
- Annex I
- Requirements for disease free statuses

## **REGULATION (EU) 2021/620**

### COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) 2021/620

of 15 April 2021

laying down rules for the application of Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the approval of the disease-free and non-vaccination status of certain Member States or zones or compartments thereof as regards certain listed diseases and the approval of eradication programmes for those listed diseases

- Annexes provide disease free statuses for Brucella abortus, B. melitensis and B. suis, MTBC, EBL, IBR/IPV, AD, BT and Varroa.
- Also lists zones or compartments of Member States where more than 75 % of the territory of
  the Member State has disease-free status from VHS, IHN, ISA, Marteilia refringens, Bonamia exitiosa, B. ostreae and white spot syndrome virus.

## Conclusion

For diseases covered by Articles 3(1)(b) and 3(1)(c) of Regulation 2020/2002, no notification required unless outbreak occurs in a in a disease-free Member State or zone (*special rules apply*  $\rightarrow$  *see articles*).

However ... ALL outbreaks will need to be included in the Union reporting (once per year) as per Art 4 of Regulation 2020/2002.
