Reporting on:

- SARS-CoV-2 in minks and other animals of the family *Mustelidae* and in raccoon dogs
- CID 2021/788 adopted on 12 May 2021
- Covers all outbreaks reported since 17 January 2023
- New outbreak reported by Poland

Poland

- **1 new SARS-CoV-2 outbreak** in minks confirmed by RT-PCR:
- **1/2023** located in voivodeship Wielkopolskie, powiat **Gniezno**
- No clinical signs nor fatality in any outbreak (samples taken as a part of active surveillance)
- Origin of the virus: investigation ongoing
- Control measures include:
 - Isolation and observation,
 - ban on movement of animals and animal surveillance,
 - official supervision for treatment of animal by-products, feed, bedding,
 - cleaning and disinfection
 - regionalisation and surveillance



Poland

- farm with 1.500 minks
- confirmed by RT-PCR on 25.01.2023
- Further control measures: Supervision of the records of daily fallen stock
- 15 dead minks on 24.01.2023, overall no increased mortality in the flock
