Detection of animal transport traffic without the documents required by law.	<p>In the last year there have been two training in animal welfare that have been raised issues concerning the protection of animals during transport. The first training was held between 4-6 June 2013 and had two parts: theoretical and practical.</p> <p>The practical part consisted in checking and filling the journey log.</p> <p>A second training was held between 17-19 October 2013, and it included presentations on inspections regarding the protection of animals during transport organized by the veterinary authority in accordance with Reg. Cons. No. 1/2005/CE and on the annual reporting to E.C.. Subsequently, trainings in cascade took place in each sanitary veterinary and food safety directorate.

It was issued the service note no. 26390/27.06.2013-INTRANET 4904 for increased inspections to verify compliance with the protection of animals during transport, between 1 July to 30 September 2013. Inspections will be conducted in the following objectives: place of departure, place of destination, in the traffic, at long distance carriers, at short distance carriers and control points. This note contains a refresh of the notification procedure of the romanian contact point, where there are identified violations of the legislation on the protection of animals during transport made by foreign carriers / drivers in national territory in accordance with Council Regulation no.1/2005, art.26.

It also intends to change the amounts of the penalties provided for GD 984/2005 as amended and supplemented, so that they are effective, proportionate and dissuasive and new legislation to cover all non-conformities identified
