



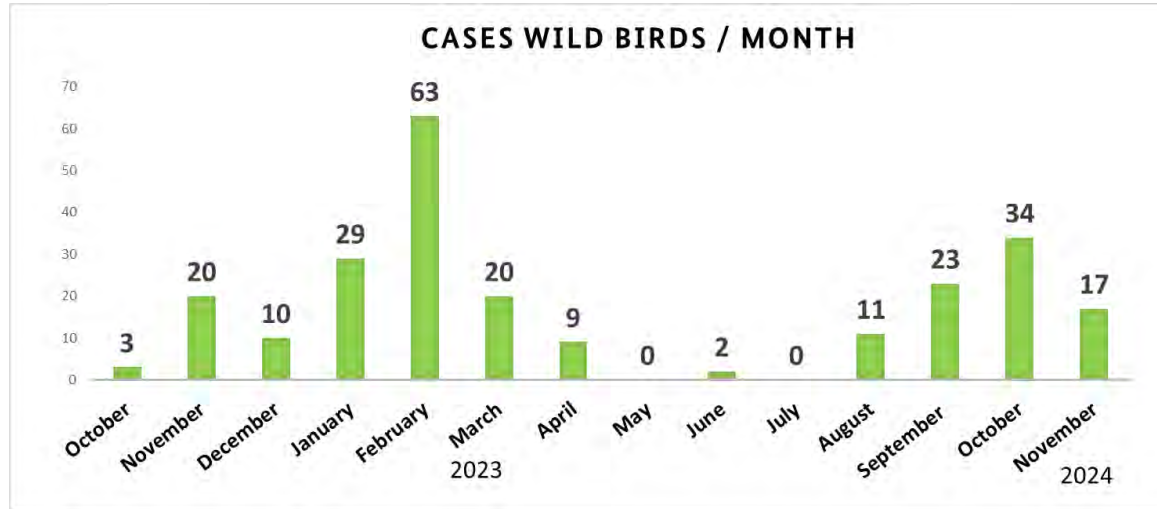

Level of HPAI cases in wild birds increased, mainly **wild geese** are affected

Bavaria 31/10/2024: 477 mixed
poultry for fattening
(geese, ducks, turkeys, broiler),
laying hens

Bavaria 25/10/2024: 80 geese for fattening

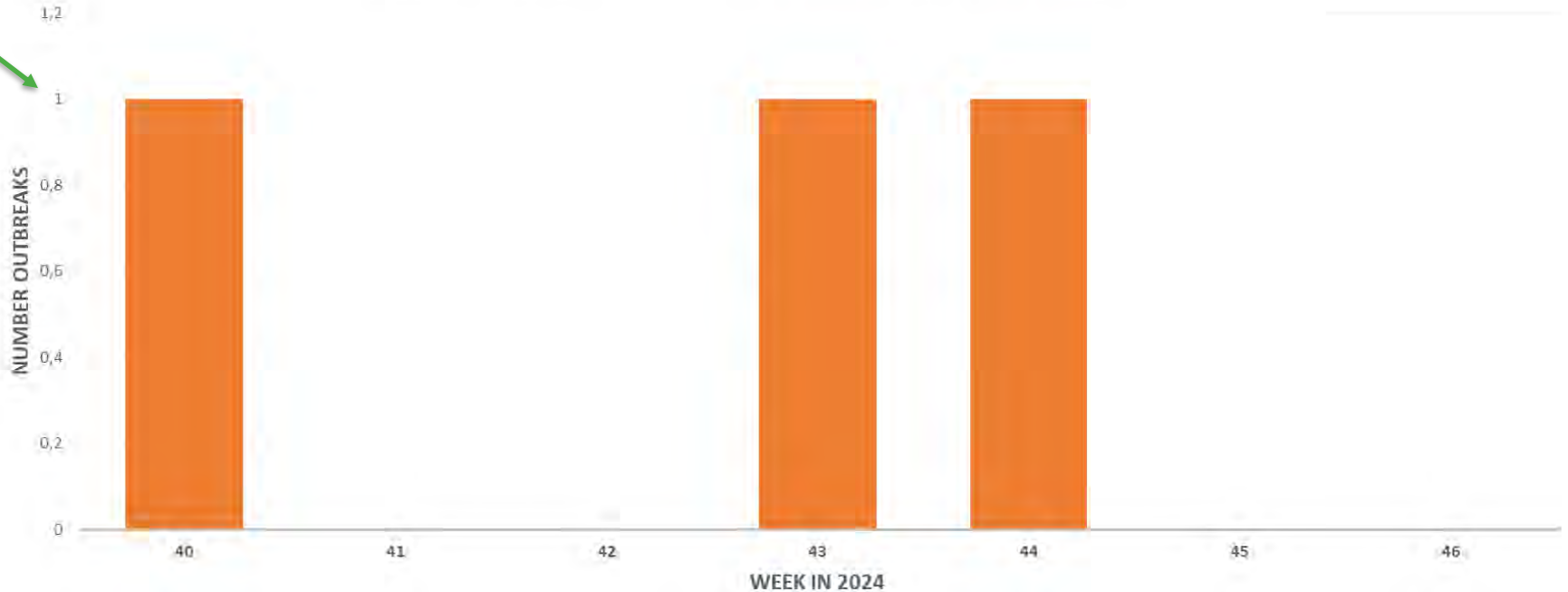
Situation in **poultry** and **captive birds**

Period of time	Number of outbreaks
Active outbreaks on 15/11/2024 (21/10/2024)	2 (6)
New from 21/10/2024 (~last PAFF) until 15/11/2024	2 Zoo: 0 Poultry: 2 NON-Poultry: 0
“Season” from 01/10/2024 until 15/11/2024	3 (1 lifted)

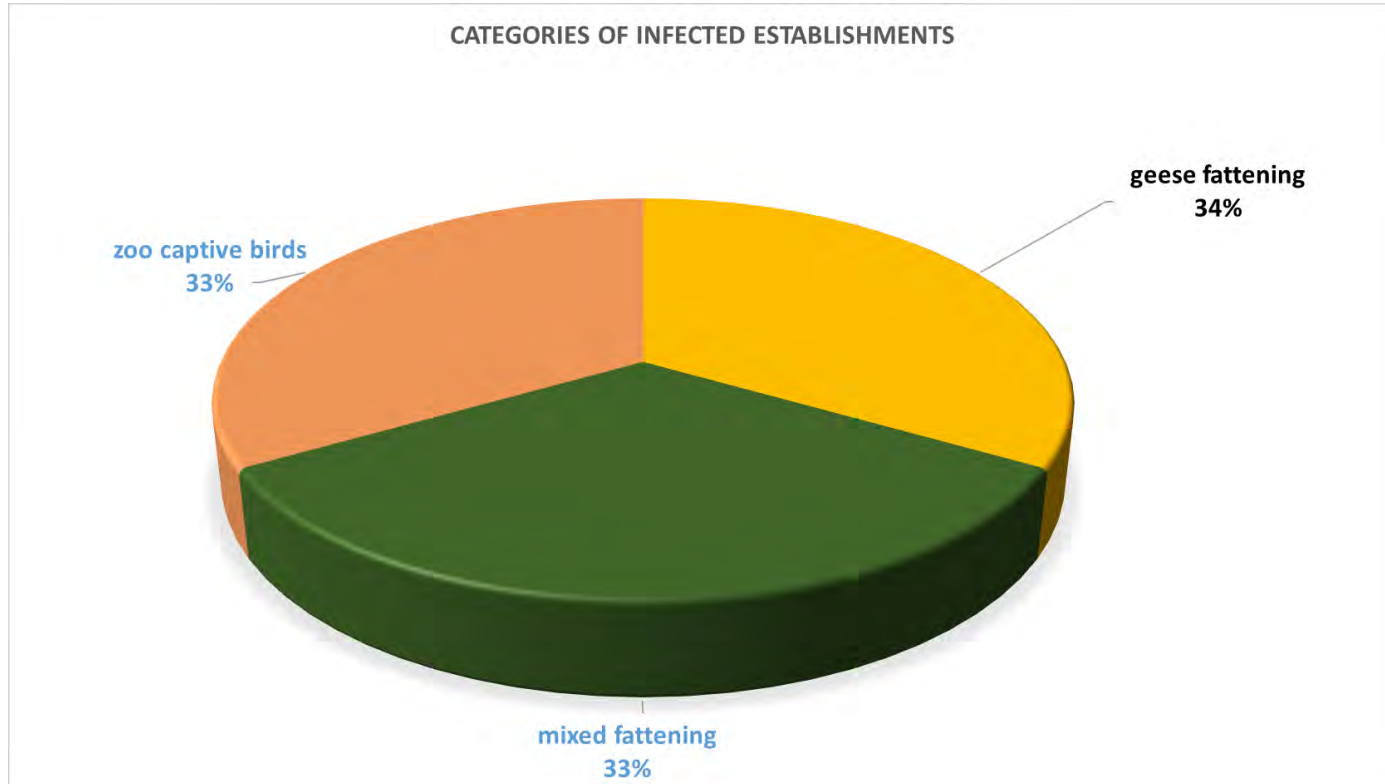


Evolution: Poultry and captive birds

Number of outbreaks per week 01/10/2024 to 15/11/2024



Establishments: Poultry and captive birds 01/10/2024 -15/11/2024



Summary

- Number of cases in **wild birds increases**
- Awareness and **preparedness** very important
- **Biosecurity measures** in poultry, captive birds and trade establishments in place
- Risk assessment results in **high risk**
