Reporting on:

- SARS-CoV-2 in minks and other animals of the family Mustelidae and in raccoon dogs
- CID 2021/788 adopted on 12 May 2021
- One new outbreak reported and several follow-up reports by Poland



Poland

- 1 new SARS-CoV-2 outbreak in minks confirmed by RT-PCR:
- 1/2022 located in voivodeship łódzkie, powiat Tomaszów Maz.
- No clinical sings 5 minks positive by RT-PCR (samples taken as a part of active surveillance)
- 3 dead minks in January 2022





Poland – 1/2022

- Confirmation date: 26.1.22
- Farm with 8.189 minks
- Origin of the virus: Infected farm worker (Tested 13.01.2022)
- Related human cases: Family member of the farm owner with Covid (Tested 20.01.2022)
- Control measures include:
 - isolation and observation,
 - ban on movement of animals, no treatment of animals
 - official supervision for treatment of animal by-products, feed, bedding,
 - cleaning and disinfection
 - surveillance within a restricted area



Poland – updated outbreak information

- 3/2021
 - Possible source of the virus:an employee testing positive for the SARS-CoV-2 virus.
 - no killing of mink has been carried out on the farm
- 7/2021 no dead animals in period 27.12.2021-16.01.2022 retesting ongoing
- 9/2021 no dead animals on farm
- 10/2021 number on animals on farm: 3600
- 11/2021 number on animals on farm: 5239 one dead mink recorded
