

animals and goods entering the Union and to which

Art. 47 + 48 do <u>not</u> apply

e.g.: FCM, mineral water, juices, novel foods, seeds ...

Art. 47 (1) Categories border controls

Art. 48 Animals and goods exempted from official controls at border control posts:

- Animals/goods ≠ to be placed on the market
- goods which have undergone specific treatment + do not exceed quantities to be established in DA
- Animals/goods categories of low / no specific risk ⇒ controls at BCP ≠ necessary

Article 46 Samples taken on animals + goods

1. Art. 34 – 42 OCR (general rules on sampling analysis, test + diagnosis) apply



- inform operators, (customs authorities)
- Decide whether animals/goods:
 - detained pending results of tests or
 - released provided ⇒ traceability
