
THE EU PLATFORM ON ANIMAL WELFARE

Digital Tool Structure

- Agora: common space open to all users
- **Sub-groups**: Restricted-access working networks on specific issues, as mandated by the Commission
- Thematic networks: accessible to all users and open to discussion on thematic issues, besides subgroups

More IT subgroups and thematic networks to be created upon the Commission's mandate




Features and functionalities
