Suspension of bluetongue disease (BTV) free status and conditions regarding movements of animals in relation to BTV

BTV free status for the entire territory of the Republic of Slovenia is suspended.

Conditions for movements of BTV susceptible animals

Pursuant to Article 13, Article 17(b), Article 24(b), Article 27(b) and Article 30(b) of Delegated Regulation 2020/688/EU and based on the Section 1, Chapter 2 Part II Annex V of Delegated Regulation 2020/689/EU, the movements of BTV susceptible animals into Slovenia (hereinafter referred to as 'animals') from Member States or areas thereof which are not free from BTV infection or are not included in a BTV eradication programme are allowed subject to one of the following conditions:

1. Animals have been protected from vector attacks by insecticides or repellents for at least 14 days prior to the date of movement and they have been subjected during that period to a PCR test, with negative results, carried out on samples collected at least 14 days following the date of protection from vector attacks; or
2. The animals have been kept in a seasonally BTV-free Member State or zone established in accordance with paragraph 3 of Article 40 of Delegated Regulation 2020/689/EU for at least 60 days prior to the date of movement; or
3. The animals have been kept in a seasonally BTV-free Member State or zone established in accordance with paragraph 3 of Article 40 of Delegated Regulation 2020/689/EU for at least 28 days prior to the date of movement and have been subjected to a serological test, with negative results, carried out on samples collected at least 28 days following the entry date of the animal into the seasonally BTV-free Member State or zone; or
4. The animals have been kept in a seasonally BTV-free Member State or zone established in accordance with paragraph 3 of Article 40 of Delegated Regulation 2020/689/EU for at least 14 days prior to the date of movement and have been subjected to a PCR test, with negative results, carried out on samples collected at least 14 days following the entry date of the animal into the seasonally BTV-free Member State or zone.

The movement of animals into Slovenia meeting the conditions set out in points 1 to 3 of Section 1 of Chapter 2 of Part II of Annex V to Delegated Regulation 2020/689/EU shall be without restrictions.
