

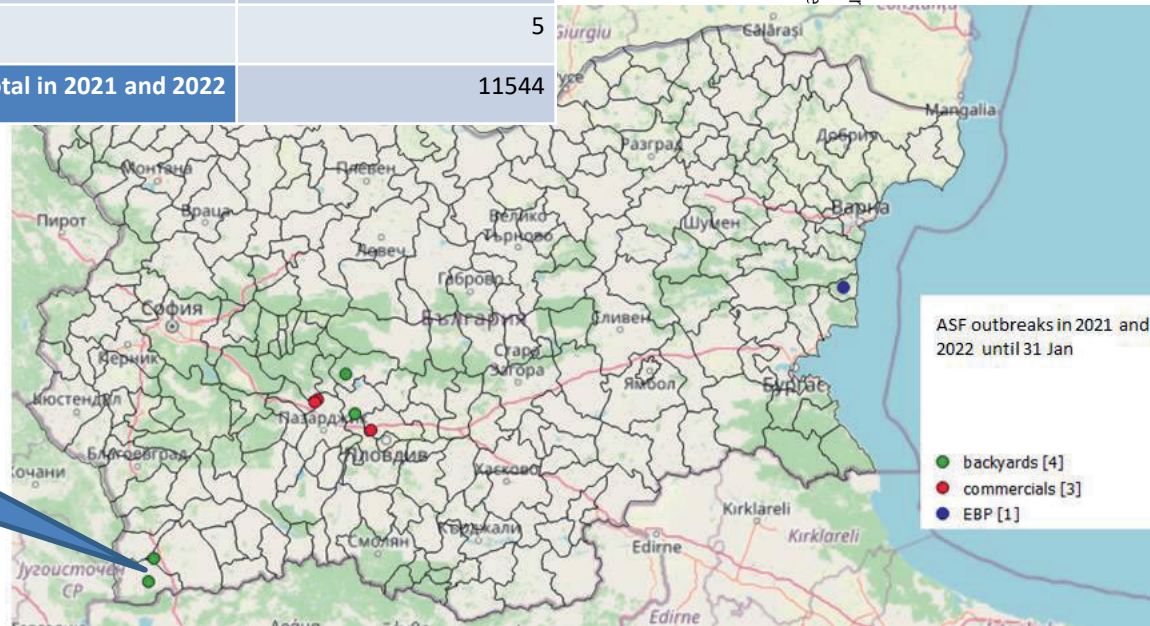
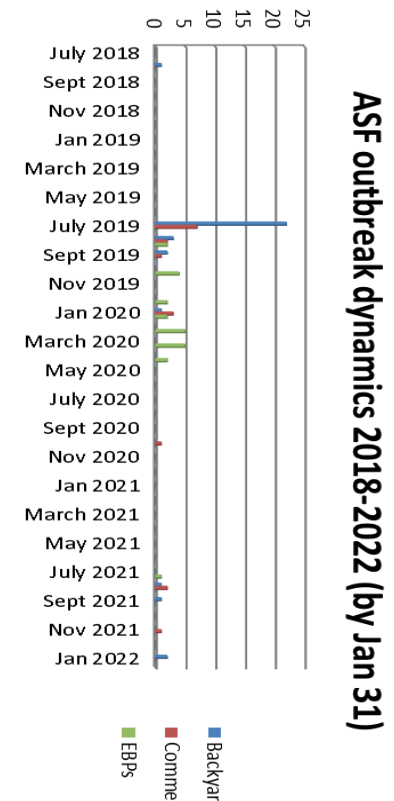

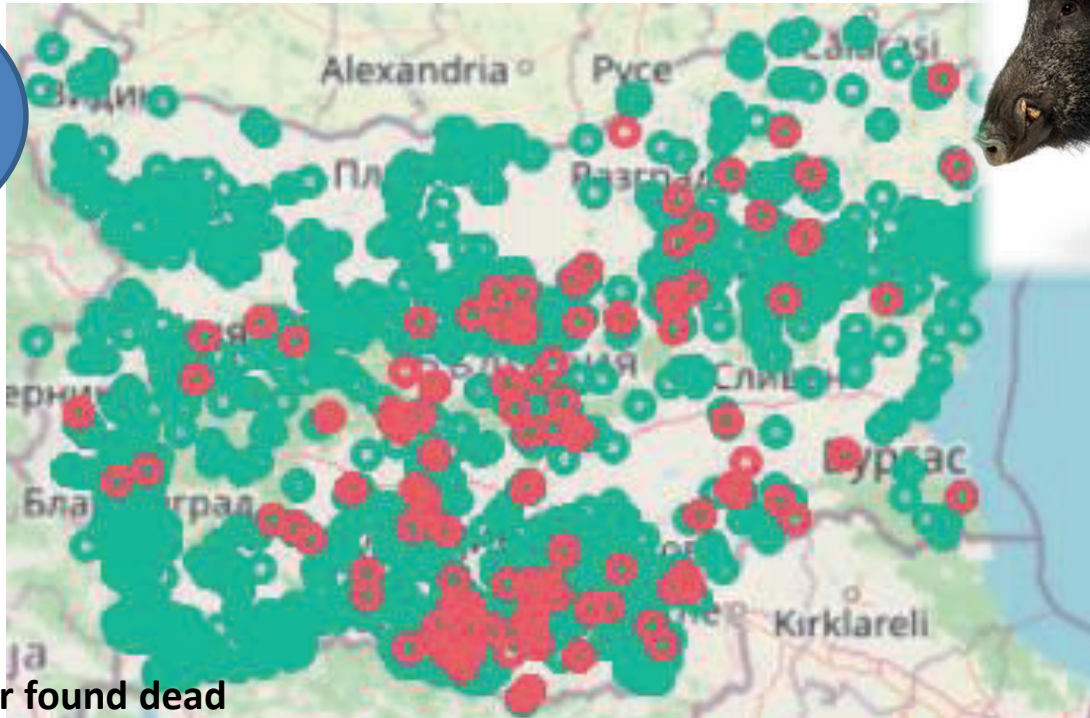


One affected region in 2022

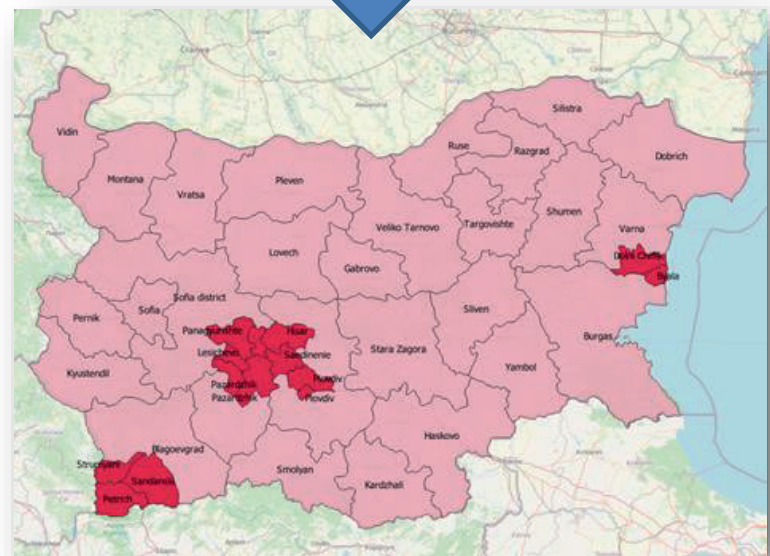
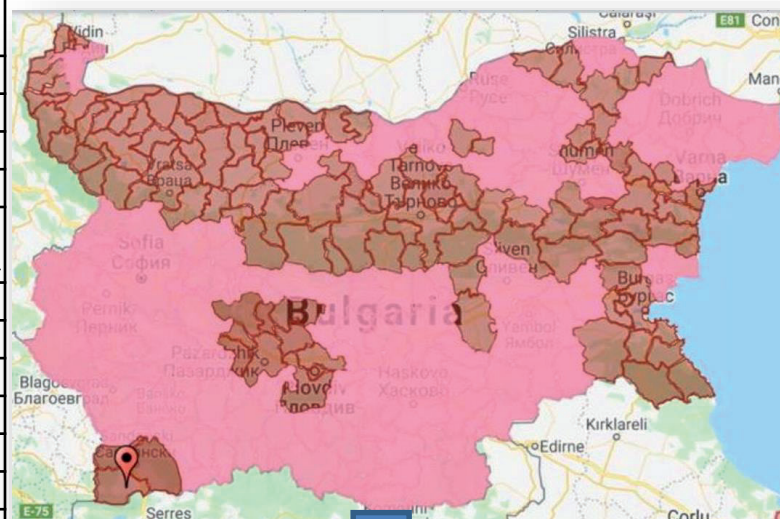

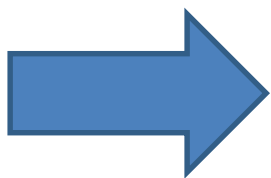

CA`s assessment/conclusion:

- Current distribution of the outbreaks in domestic pigs -> no dynamics in the north part of BG since Oct 2020
- The main risks stay with the non-commercial farms or EBPs which do not have impact on the main live pig/pig products trading patterns



Campaign enforced by BFSA:

- *with local governors and mayors for inventory*
- *enhanced official biosecurity checks in high risk zones*

- The measures applied with regard to the commercial farms are currently well understood by operators and are prerequisite for overall improvement of the pig sector in terms of disease prevention and early detection.
