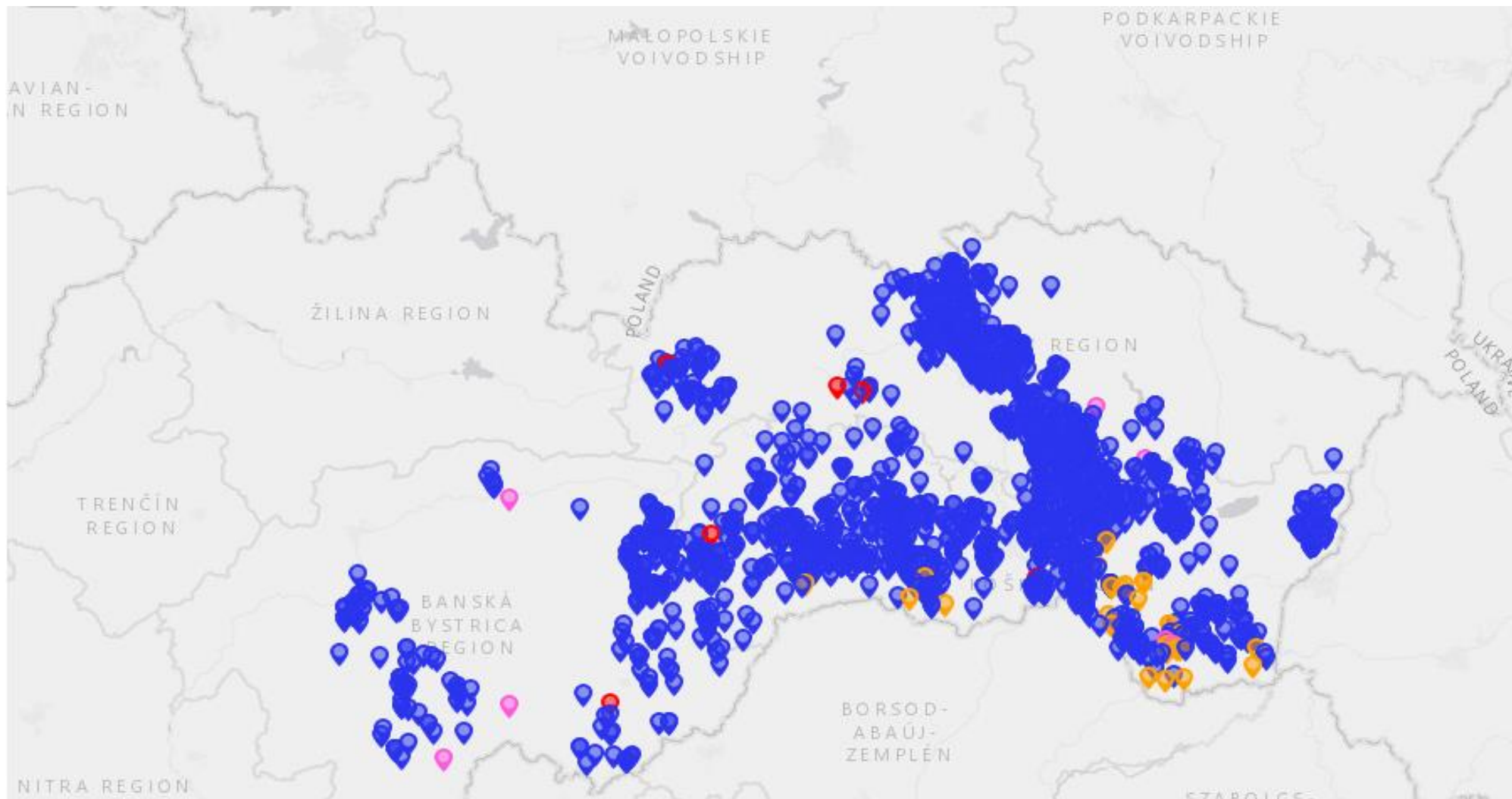

ASF in Slovakia – state of play – year 2021 – till 20.09.2021

- Year 2021: 747 ADNS + 687 ADIS reports (incl one by domestic pigs, other WB)
- 687 ADIS reports- 21 regions affected
- TWO new regions included in the part II
 - LIPTOVSKÝ MIKULÁŠ north part of Slovakia ASF- 2021
 - SNINA north-east part of Slovakia (bordering Ukraine)
- FIVE new regions included in the part III – due to positive outbreaks in domestic pigs during summer period (Jun- August 2021):
 - HUMENNÉ, VRANOV n/T, MICHALOVCE – east part of Slovakia
 - BREZNO – central part of Slovakia
 - VEĽKÝ KRTÍŠ – south part of Slovakia

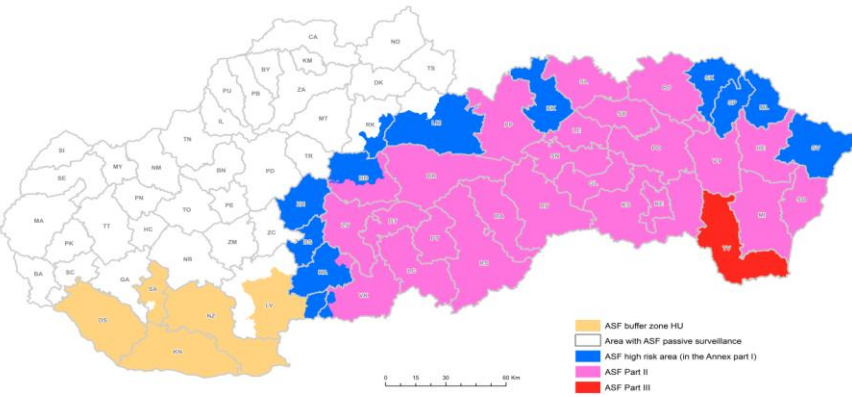

Schematic map of the Slovak territory – from June to September, 2021

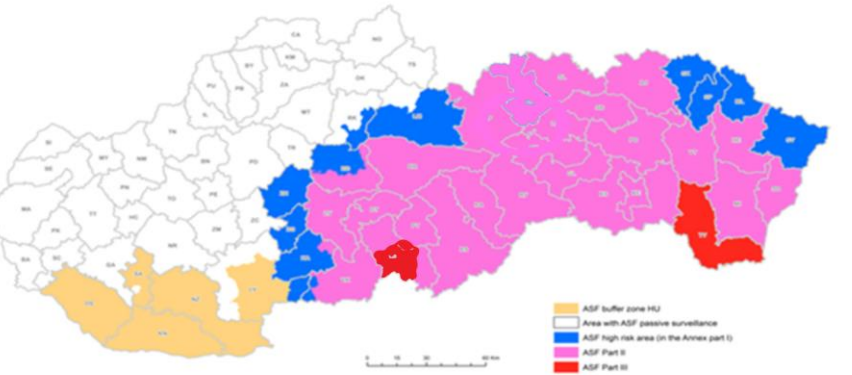

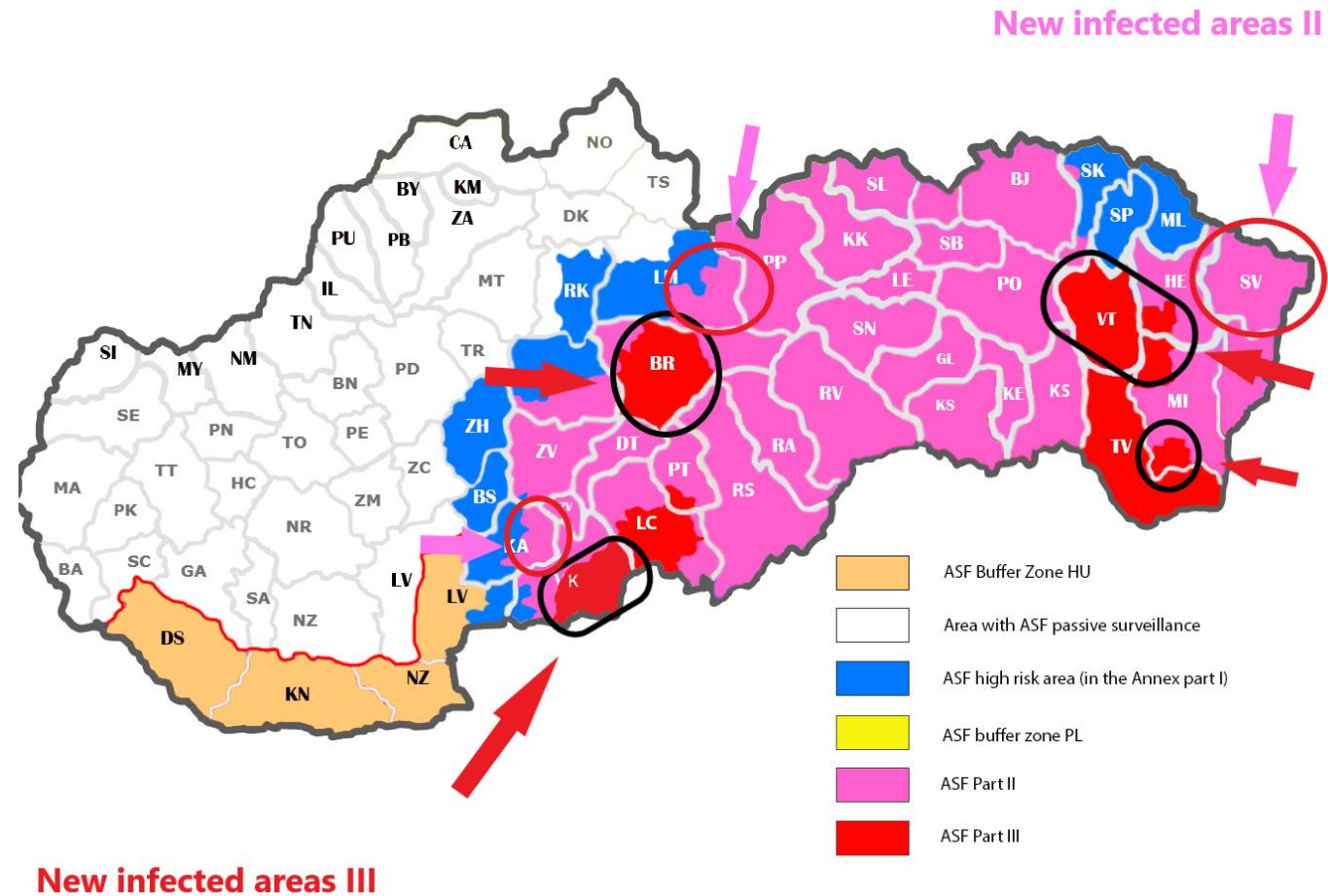

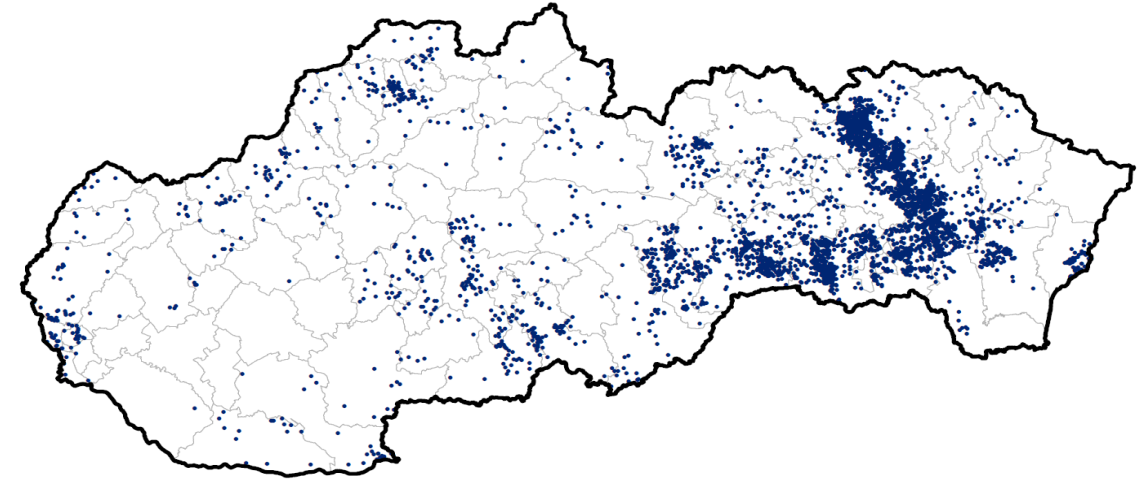

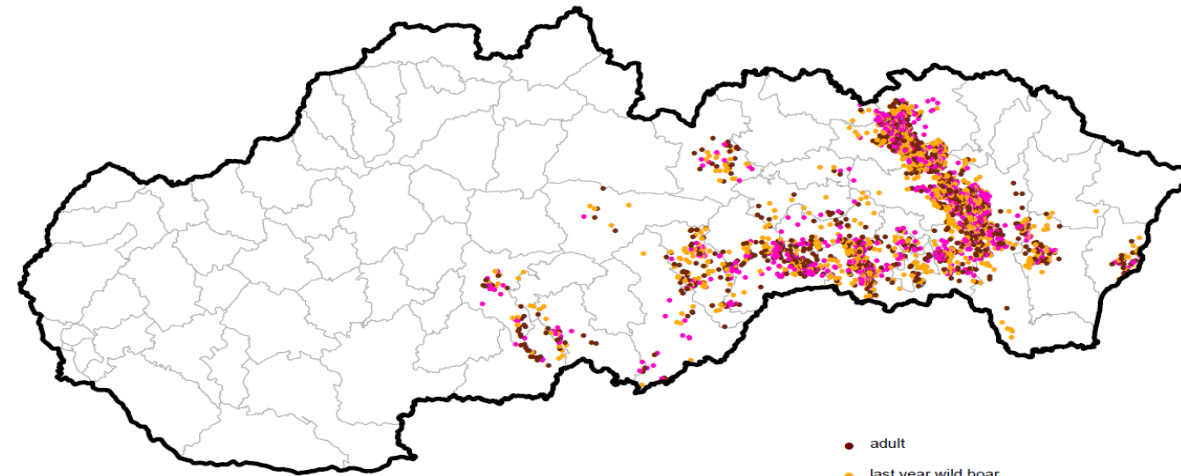

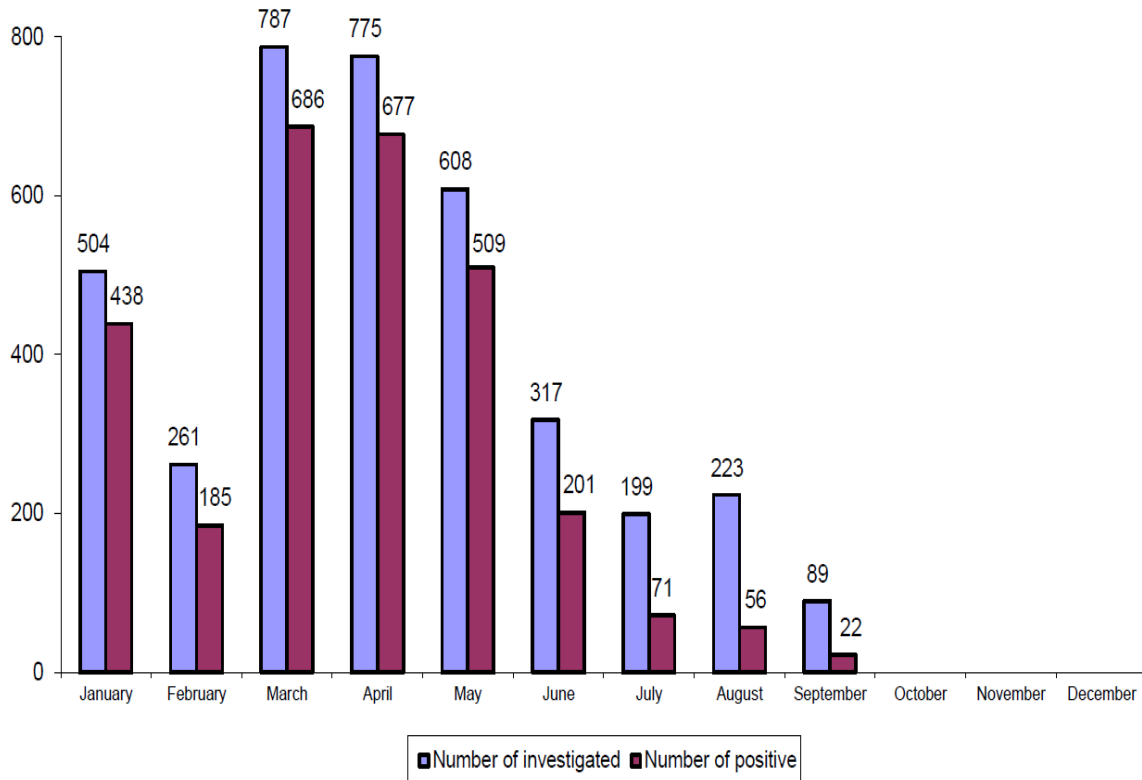
Geographical distribution of wild boars samples positive for ASF virus in Slovakia during 2021 (January - 10 September) - passive surveillance



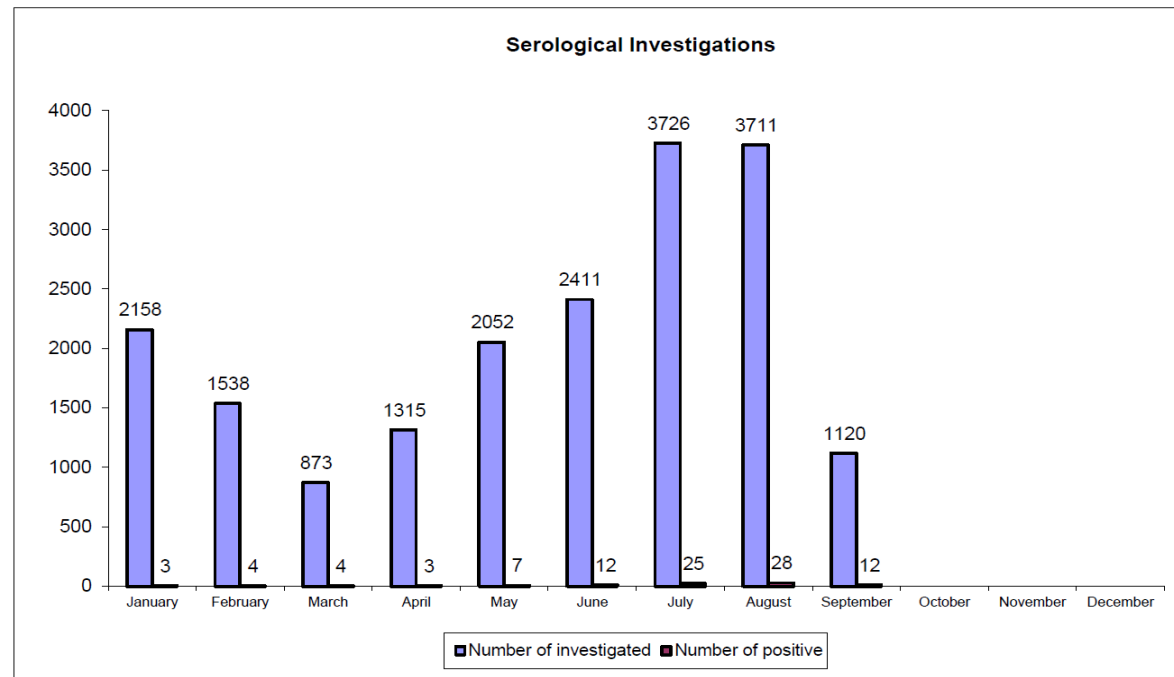
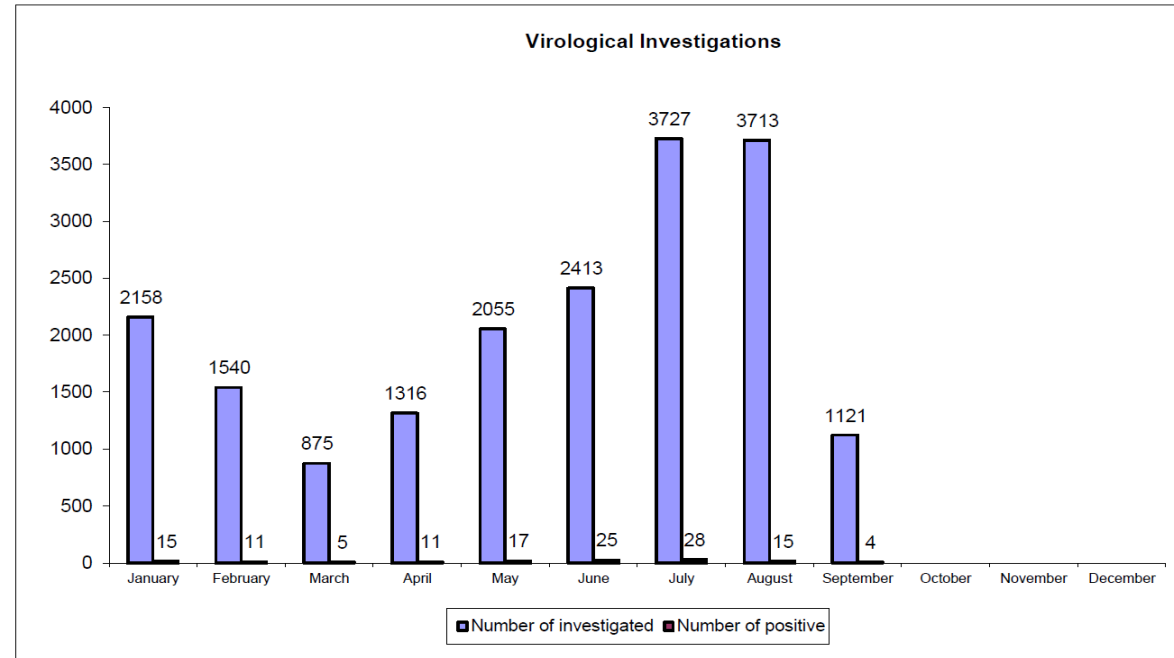

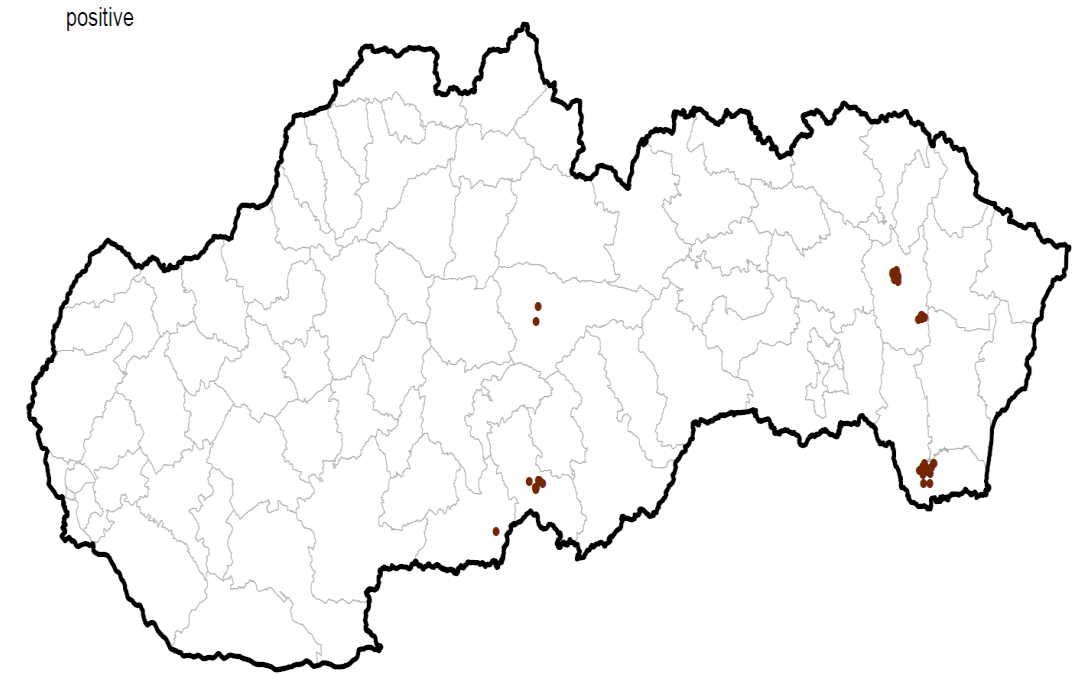


Laboratory Investigations of ASF in wild boars in Slovakia during 2021 (January - 10 September) - active surveillance



ASF in domestic pigs

- June 2021 - the first ASF outbreak in 2021, one big commercial farm in Lučenec district
- July 2021
 - 4 ASF outbreaks, small commercial and non-commercial holdings (all farms less than 100 pigs)
 - In the districts Brezno, Veľký Krtíš and Vranov n/T – disease never occurred before
- August 2021 – 2 ASF outbreaks in small commercial and non-commercial holdings (all farms less than 25 pigs)
- Last confirmation on **4.8.2021**
- From 4.8. 2021 - until now – **ASF was not detected in domestic pigs**
- Protection zone and surveillance zone demarcated
- The veterinary measures in force in accordance with relevant legislation - the movement of pigs prohibited
- The depopulation of holdings done immediately after confirmation the occurrence /the presence of virus in the holdings

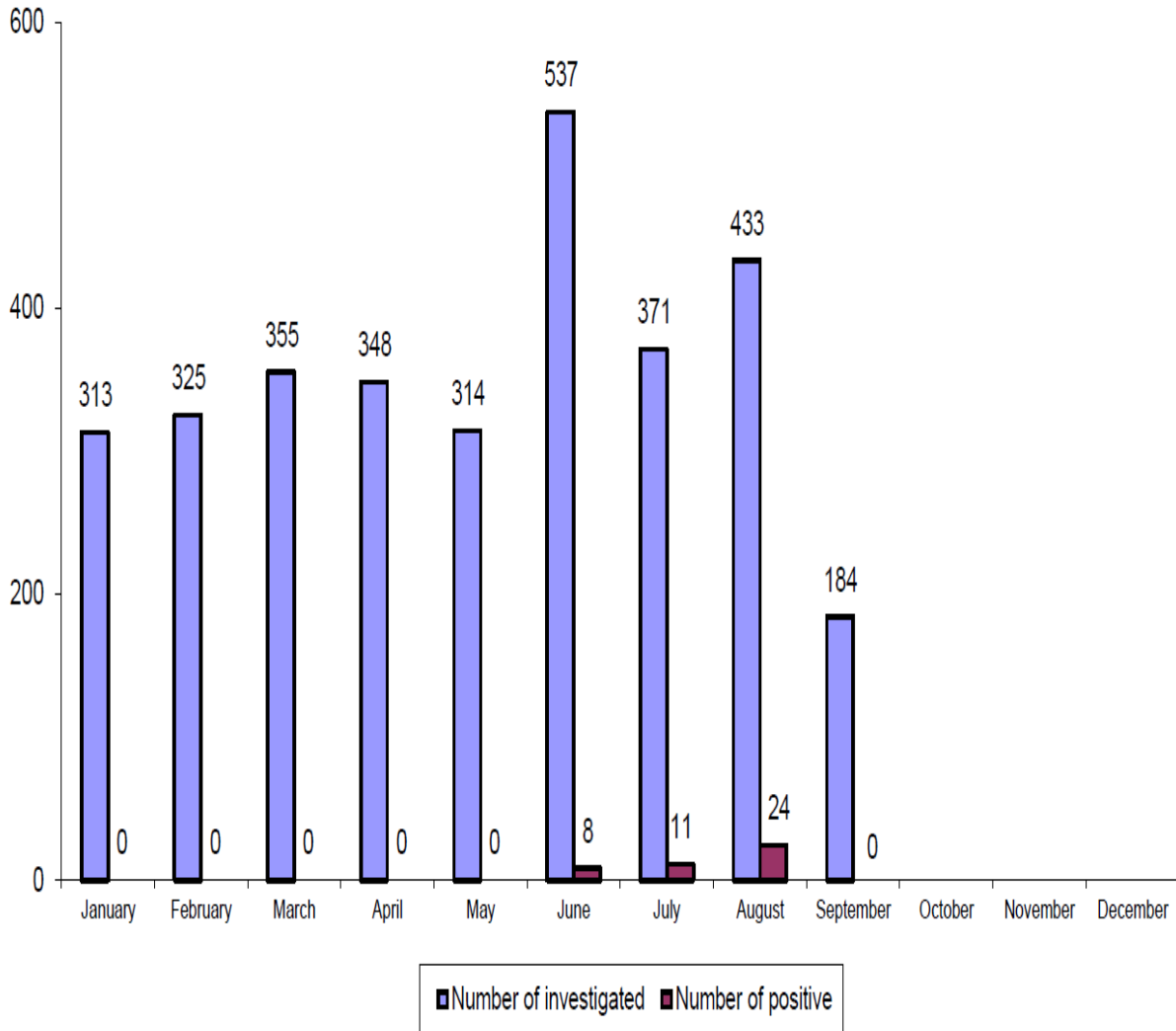
ASF in domestic pigs

- ASF monitoring in place - every week (2 samples)
- All ASF positive results were detected by death pigs
- Movement pigs from the farms – only slovak slaughterhouses (more than 1 month before introduction of ASFV)
- No movement of pigs from the farm into the MS
- High level of biosecurity in the commercial farms, lower level of biosecurity in the non-commercial farms

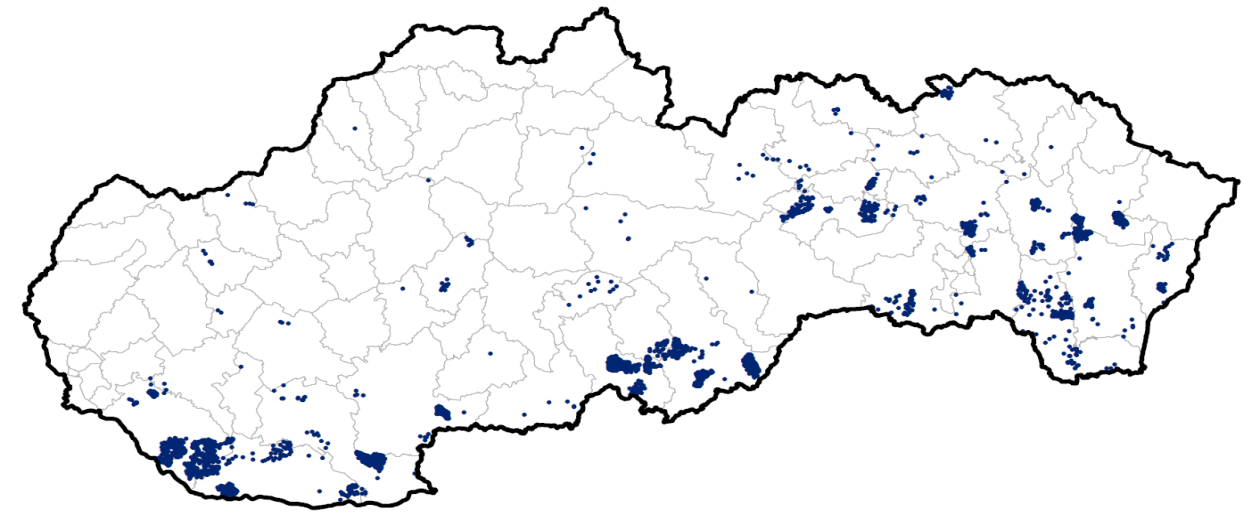
Laboratory Investigations of ASF in domestic pigs in Slovakia during 2021 (January - 10 September)

Geographical distribution of samples submitted for ASF virus investigation in domestic swine in Slovakia during 2021 (January - 10 September)

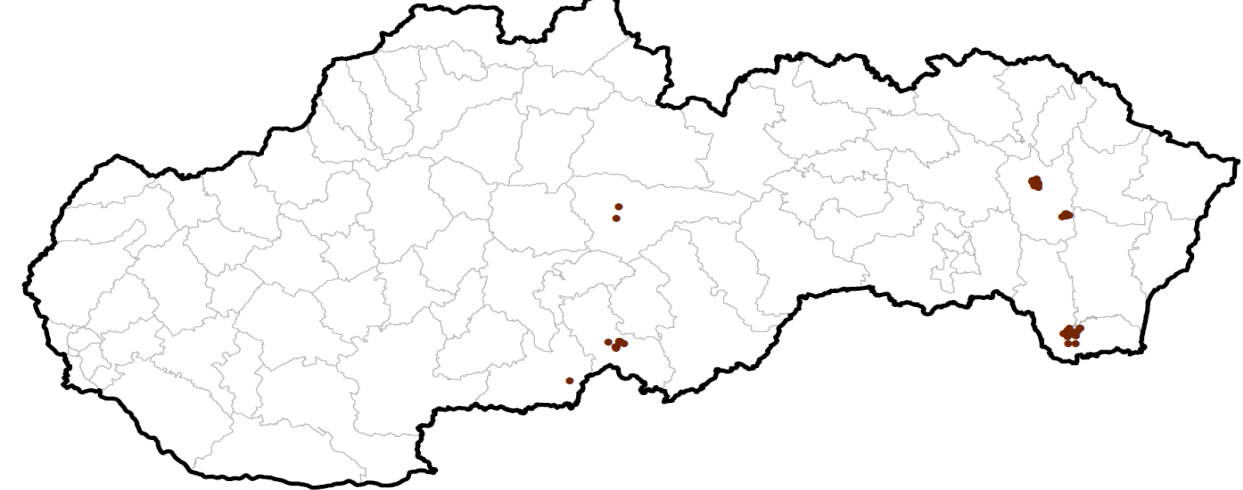

Summary - wild boars

- 3 further updates of zones - in two new districts (L.Mikuláš, Snina)
- In new infected area – measures adapted as necessary for part II hunting grounds , pigs holdings)
- Trainings of hunters in place on the whole territory of Slovakia (ASF topic a part of the agenda)

Summary – domestic pigs

- All veterinary measures in outbreak, protection zone and surveillance zone – in force/ordered/adopted
- New infected zone III in region V. Krtíš, Brezno, Vranov n/T, Michalovce and Humenné established
- Eradication of ASF outbreak – in all cases - finished
- Clinical examination and sampling in the protection/surveillance zones – in progress
- No further ASF outbreak (from 4.8.2021 till now)

Activities and competences of the SVFA/CVO

- New extraordinary veterinary measures – ordered by CVO – management of ASF
- Very intensive campaign in the free areas in order to reduce the population of WB closely to 0 (0,3-0,5 od WB /km²)
- The distribution of cooling boxes for hunting grounds – further round of distribution – in progress
- Very intensive information campaign and the meetings of expert group consisting from big farmers, hunters associations, veterinarians – organised by State Veterinary and Food Administration and the Ministry of Agriculture – in order to highlight to the parties involved their task and role in the process of ASF management (3 meetings)
- Special meeting of State Veterinary and Food Administration and the representatives of central database organised – the goal: improvement of the system of registration and clear overview of the pig holding categorisation
- The check of summary of controls of biological safety of holding carried out by official vets at district level – in progress
- Exchange of information- seminar of ASF organised by AT colleagues- very comprehensive and useful exchange of views- will be summarised by memorandum of cooperation and experience sharing (by the end of September 2021– participated countries- AT, CZ, SK, HU)
- And ...the reply of SK authorities to the recommendations expressed by EC auditors as a consequence of ASF remote audit carried out in Slovakia In February /March 2021 by Directorate F DG SANTE
