DG SANTE Unit D1 - Farm to Fork Strategy

From EG GFL to EG GFL SFS

- EG on general food law established in 2014
 - To engage with MS on horizontal matters relating to the food chain
- May 2020: adoption of the Farm to Fork Strategy
 - Configuration of EG GFL no longer adequate to discuss issues related to sustainability of food systems
- Autumn 2020: revamp of the EG GFL into EG GFL SFS
 - Tasks and composition of the EG broadened (terms of reference published on Commission Register of expert groups)



Tasks of the new EG

- To assist DG SANTE in the preparation of legislative proposals and policy initiatives in the field of food law and food systems sustainability
- To assist DG SANTE in the preparation of delegated acts on the abovementioned fields.
- To establish cooperation and coordination between the Commission and Member States on questions relating to the implementation of Union legislation, programmes and policies
- To assist DG SANTE in the early preparation of implementing acts
- To bring about an exchange of experience and good practices



Membership

- MS to appoint representatives from different ministries/agencies having expertise in food law and sustainability of food systems.
 - Setting up of a pool of experts within each MS
 - Relevant experts to be sent depending on the topic to be discussed at each meeting
- The Commission will reimburse up to 3 experts per MS (each one from a different agency/ministry) for each meeting.
