	TOPIC	BACKGROUND
1	Art. 77.3.a: Certificates COM presented a draft implementing regulation. The discussion that followed mainly revolved around the provisions concerning the certificates for consignments destined to NATO bases located in the Union territory and several clarifications where asked by MS on this matter. COM provided clarifications on the points raised by MS. More in particular, it was explained that the text will be amended to be in line with Delegated act developed under empowerment of Article 77.1.c of OCR and guidance	Draft document shared with Member States ahead of the meeting
2	act developed under empowerment of Article 77.1.c of OCR and guidance notes concerning completion of the certificate will be developed. Art. 52: Annex III on plant checks COM presented an updated version of Annex III of Art. 52, on detailed rules on operations to be carried out during physical checks on goods referred in Art. 4(6), which was welcomed by most MS. Many MS requested clarification on the suggested post import inspections, in terms of how these will be facilitated and organized. Moreover, reference was also made to the necessity of revising the sampling schemes and the level of detection. Overall, many MS highlighted the need to devote another discussion on this within PAFF committee. COM provided clarifications in all the points raised by MS and reassured MS that the intention is to keep this discussion ongoing. It was also highlighted that the issue of post import checks with the use of CHED and IMSOC will have to be discussed internally with colleagues from the competent Unit. COM welcomed the MS's comments and suggestions on this matter by 18 January 2019.	Draft document shared with Member States ahead of the meeting
