


ASF Epidemiological situation



CURRENT MEASURES FOR KEPT PIGS

All pig holdings must be registred in National Data Base. All pigs must be identified and registred

Biosecurity requirments

- backyards - noncomercial establishments (pigs are raised for fattening and are slaughtered for family consumption; the sale of pigs or pig products is prohibited)

- small commercial farms sanitary veterinary registred establishments (former type A holdings)
- big commercial farms sanitary veterinary authorised establishments

Movement requirments - as provided in CIR (EU) 2023/594

- compliant farms - to other establishment, within RO territory (all Part III), art. 28 (2)

- or to designated slaughterhouse art. 44(1); meat with special health mark for RO territory only

rder 132/418/ 2023

Dio Law

- Order 130/2023

- noncompliant farms to designated slaughterhouse art. 44(1), on risk base analyze;
 - meat marked and sent for processing (Annex VII of DR 687)

Inspection regime

- noncommercial farms min once per year + owner request, other s-v actions
 - counselling actions (10/month/empowered vet)
 - risk base approach
- commercial farms as provided in CIR (EU) 2023/594

Traffic controls (Vets&Police&Jandarms) with the aim of detecting illegal movements of pigs and their products



CURRENT MEASURES FOR WILD BOAR

- Order 1850/153/2024

Ro NSVFSA in collaboration with the Ministry of Environment, Waters and Forests has applied measures, in accordance with the European Strategy, to reduce viral pressure in the forest environment by:

Increasing incentives amount for **passive surveillance** and active search

- 45 € → 200 € found dead wb/ sampled/ ABP unit
- 45 € \rightarrow 100 € found dead wb/ sampled/ alternative burial
- $0 \rightarrow$ Equivalent to 12l of fuel / month / active patrols

Granting incentives for active surveillance/hunting


- 13 € = 13 € sampled hunted wb
- $0 \rightarrow 200 \in \text{positive hunted wb/ ABP unit}$
- $0 \rightarrow 100 \in$ positive hunted wb/ alternative method
- $0 \rightarrow 100 \in$ negative hunted wb/ private consumption


Map of counties without ASF outbreaks in kept porcine, since 01.03.2024
