**AGENDA OF THE EU PREPARATORY MEETING ON 2 JUNE 2016
FOR THE WTO SANITARY AND PHYTOSANITARY COMMITTEE OF JUNE 2016**

The meeting will prepare the 66th regular meeting of the WTO Committee on Sanitary and Phytosanitary measures (SPS Committee) that will take place at the Centre William Rappard, Geneva on **30 June and 1 July 2016**. The meeting will be preceded by an informal meeting on 29 June.

At the preparatory meeting of 2nd June, the European Commission (COM) intends to discuss with Member States (MS) the main points of the agenda of the next SPS Committee. At this stage, only the preliminary agenda of the Committee is available. The final agenda will be circulated by the WTO Secretariat on 17 June 2016.
