





The Transition Pathways Stakeholder Support Platform and the Code of Conduct

- The agri-food version of the Platform aims to give support to the signatories of the Code
 of Conduct (showing their pledges, sharing best practices, facilitating networking with the
 community features, etc.)
- The objective is to launch the agri-food Platform in Q1 2025
- A retail version of the Platform will also be developed with the same timeline
- We plan to organise a workshop on the Platform in January 2025 to gather feedback
