| COM presented a revised draft, which in addition to the drafting of the <br> recitals, set out the conditions for the performance of identity and physical <br> checks at control points and the operations during and after identity and <br> physical checks at control points into two articles (3\&4). |  |  |
| Some MS pointed out that the terms "closely located" in Article 4 (4) (a) <br> lacked precisions and that it should be reworded. One MS was concerned <br> about the date of application as the text makes a reference to another draft <br> only applicable in 2022. | Draft document shared <br> with Member States ahead <br> of the meeting. |  |
| Some MS supported the idea that uncovered consignments coming from <br> third countries are not more risky than other consignments with only a 1\% <br> frequency rate and that a derogation should be considered. | COM indicates its readiness to further consider the derogation for wood of <br> conifers, in view of the economic importance of ongoing trade and the <br> possibilities to mitigate risks . <br> MS made some practical and technical comments in order to clarify the <br> draft. |  |
