### Article 50

- By 14 December 2021, the Commission shall present a report to the European Parliament and the Council on the enforcement and effectiveness of measures relating to imports into the Union territory, including a cost-benefit analysis, and, where appropriate, present a legislative proposal.

### Article 79

- By 14 December 2021, the Commission shall present a report to the European Parliament and the Council to present the experience gained from the extension of the plant passport system to all movements of plants for planting within the Union territory, including a cost-benefit analysis for the operators, accompanied, if appropriate, by a legislative proposal.
