SUMMARY

 - BTV, IBR, ASF/CSF

SUMMARY

- **Comments regarding assembly operations**

 - Validity of certificates, time limits, regular interval for cleaning and disinfection, certification of animals assembled on a means of transport

- **Comments on poultry and captive birds (Articles 34, 37,38 and 59)**
 - Residency period, «less than 20 heads»
