Outcome of the public consultation

- ✓ Total received within the EU/EEA: 56 feedbacks
 - ✓ 38 stakeholders (including bovine, porcine, equine, poultry, bees, pets and zoos associations and animal welfare NGOs)
 - ✓ 2 public authorities
 - ✓ 10 particular citizens
 - ✓ 6 anonymous
