<p>Article 48. Requirements to Hygiene of Personnel at Handling Area of Food Products</p>	<p align="center">CHAPTER VIII – PERSONAL HYGIENE</p>
<p>1. Market operators shall comply with the hygiene requirements of personnel working at handling areas of food products as follows:</p> <p>1) personnel shall be admitted to the facility without any counter-indications regarding handling of food products, having completed training of the market operator on personnel hygiene, accordingly confirmed by relevant records of such market operator;</p> <p>2) personnel of each facility shall be periodically trained on hygiene requirements for the production and circulation of food products handled by the market operator. The market operator defines the frequency of such training.</p>	<p>1. Every person working in a food-handling area is to maintain a high degree of personal cleanliness and is to wear suitable, clean and, where necessary, protective clothing.</p> <p>2. No person suffering from, or being a carrier of a disease likely to be transmitted through food or afflicted, for example, with infected wounds, skin infections, sores or diarrhoea is to be permitted to handle food or enter any food-handling area in any capacity if there is any likelihood of direct or indirect contamination. Any person so affected and employed in a food business and who is likely to come into contact with food is to report immediately the illness or symptoms, and if possible their causes, to the food business operator.</p>
