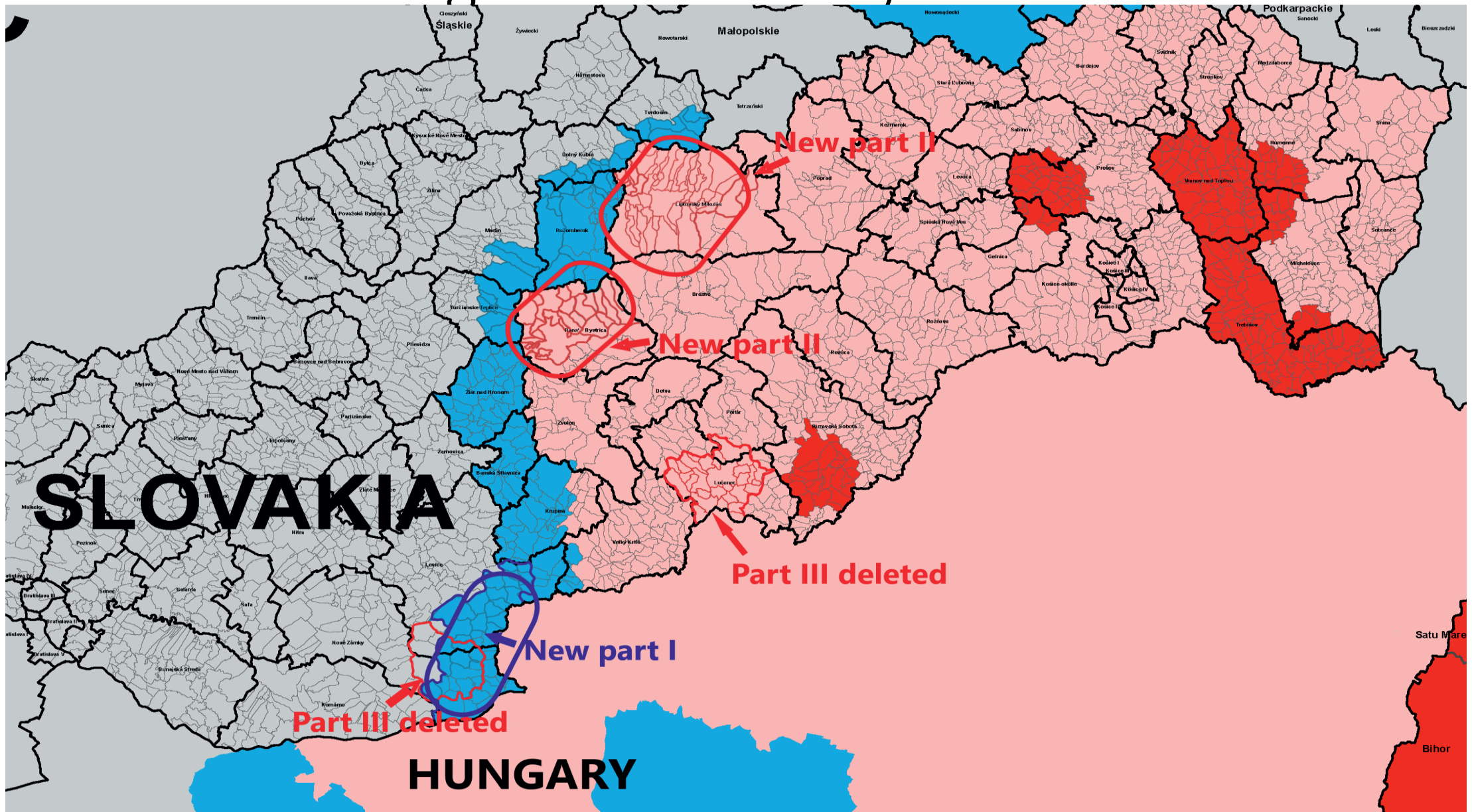

ASF in Slovakia – state of play – year 2022 till 05.04.2022

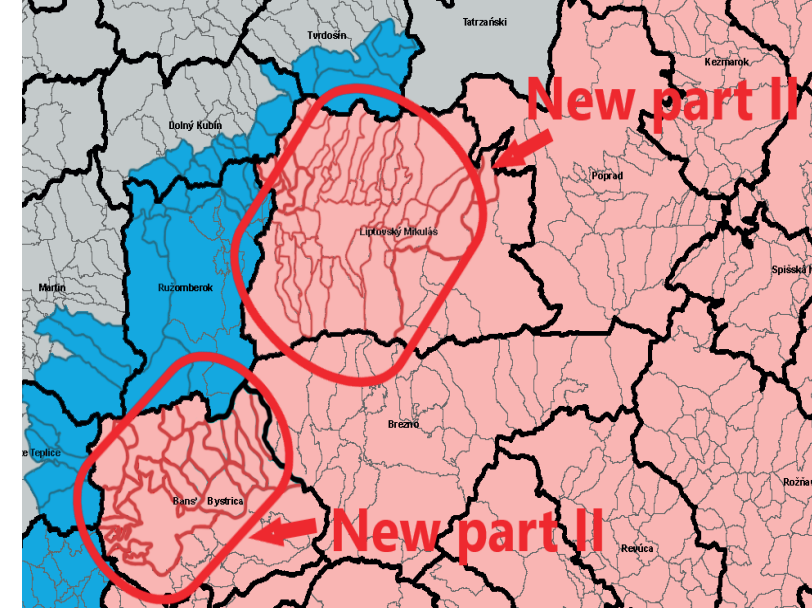
- Year 2022: **228** ADIS reports
- From the LAST PAFF Committee where Sk presented the situation (February 2022) the updates made in TWO regions already affected in wild boars, (these regions already in part II, only an enlargement within these regions done - regions Liptovský Mikuláš and Banská Bystrica) – see map
- Two reverting exercises related to domestic pigs applied (region Lučenec – from part III to part II) and region Nové Zámky deleted completely
- High risk area (part I) has been enlarged – on the Slovak-Hungarian border – by reflecting the situation in Hungary
- All these changes included in CIR 2002/491/EC dated on 25.03.2022
- **No new ASF outbreak in domestic pigs from January 2022 (in 2022 only one outbreak confirmed)**

New part II

- TWO new regions affected in wild boars
- Found death positive wild boars in the municipality in part I a few kilometres from already infected zones ADIS 2022/196, ADIS 2022/197
- Whole regions (Liptovský Mikuláš and Banská Bystrica) were included in to Part II



New part I - Slovak-Hungarian border

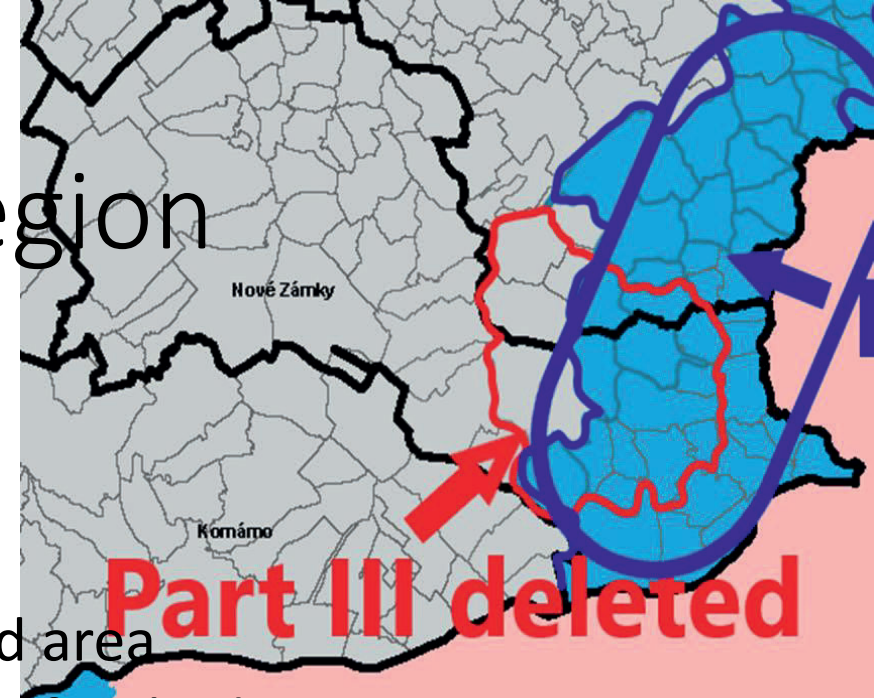
- Parts of two regions (Levice , Nové Zámky)
- No ASF positive wild boars till now in the regions
- High risk of introduction of ASF virus from Hungary
- Proactive demarcation of the new part I
- the measures for hunting grounds adopted (adapted)

Active t/passive surveillance in WB in place

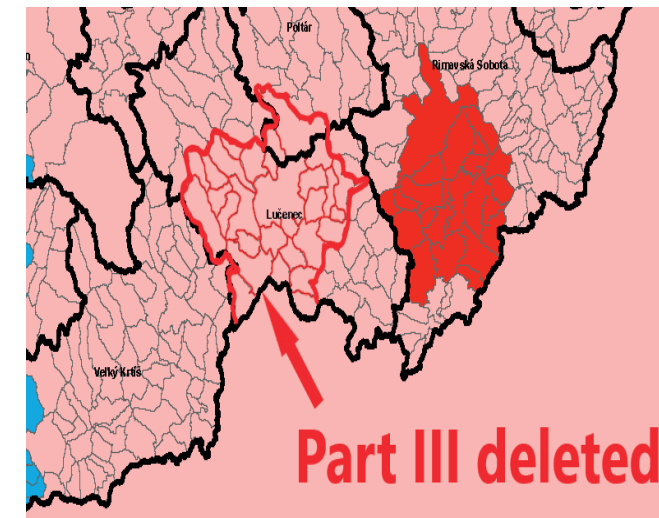


Part III deleted – Nové Zámky region

- Parts of two regions (Levice , Nové Zámky)
- One single ASF outbreak in the region
- ASF free area till detection of outbreak (3.12.2021)
- ASF virus introduction by legal movements from infected area
- ASF outbreak eradicated – final cleaning and disinfection finished
- All pig farms (included backyards farms) clinical examined in the infected region
 - 29 pig farms examined (All with negative result)
 - 169 samples taken (All with negative result)
- Lifting of veterinary measures according Regulation 2020/687
- No positive ASF result in wild boars in these area (36 samples passive monitoring- all negat.)

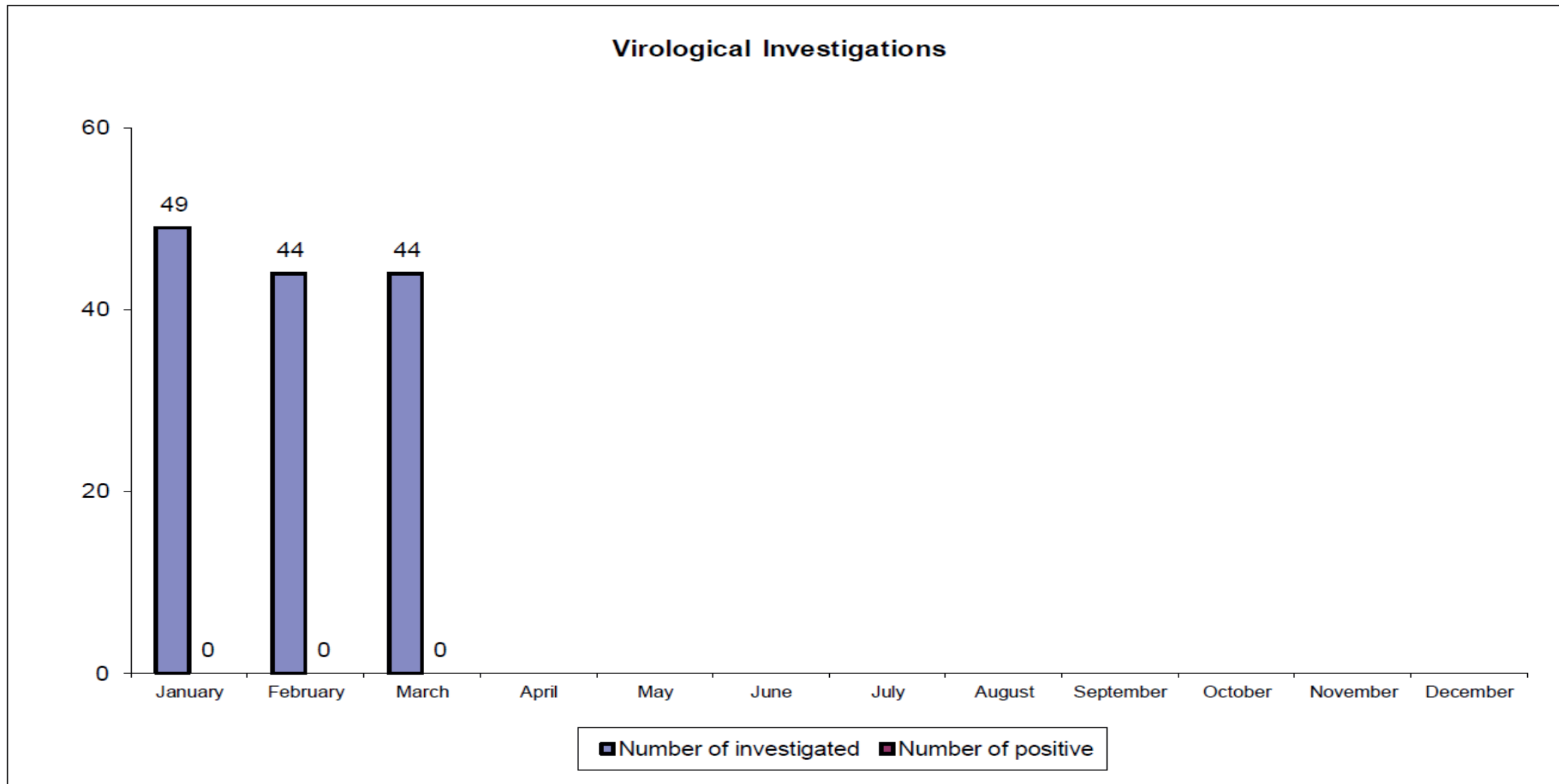


Part III deleted – Lučenec region



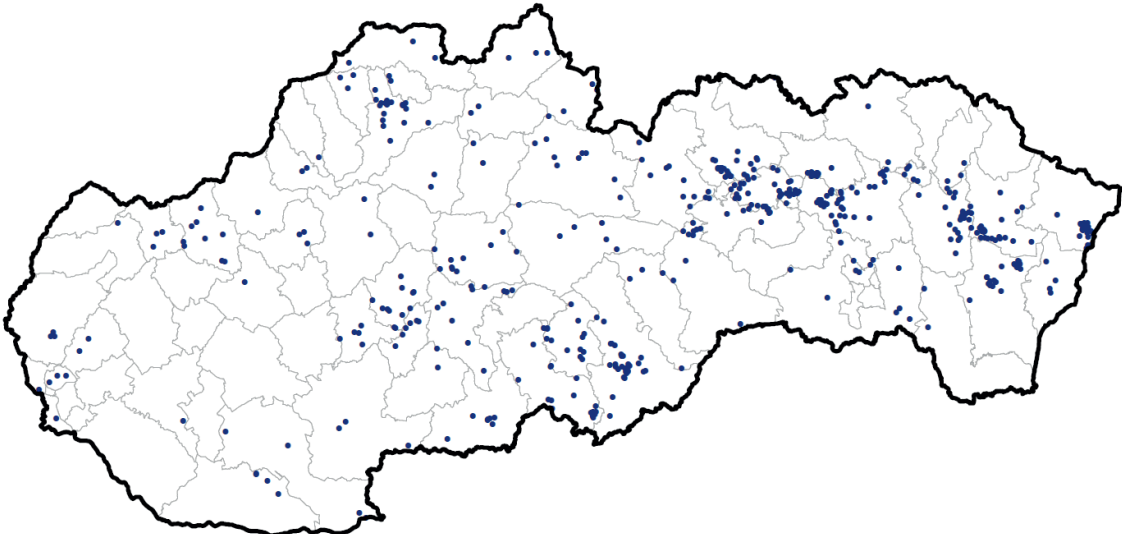
- One single ASF outbreak in the region
- ASF outbreak eradicated – final cleaning and disinfection finished
- the affected establishment till last month- empty; sentinels there right now without any problems
- All pig farms (included backyards farms) clinical examined in the restricted zone
 - 111 pig farms examined (All with negative result)
 - 415 (this year 137) samples taken (All with negative result)
- Lifting of veterinary measures according Regulation 2020/687
- Whole region stays in Part II
- Passive surveillance in domestic in place – 137 samples in the year 2022 – all negative
- Veterinary measures according Regulation 2021/605 - in place
- All farms must be checked within year 2022 for biosecurity – in progress
- Following the data: we are convinced – there is no virus circulation in domestic farms till now

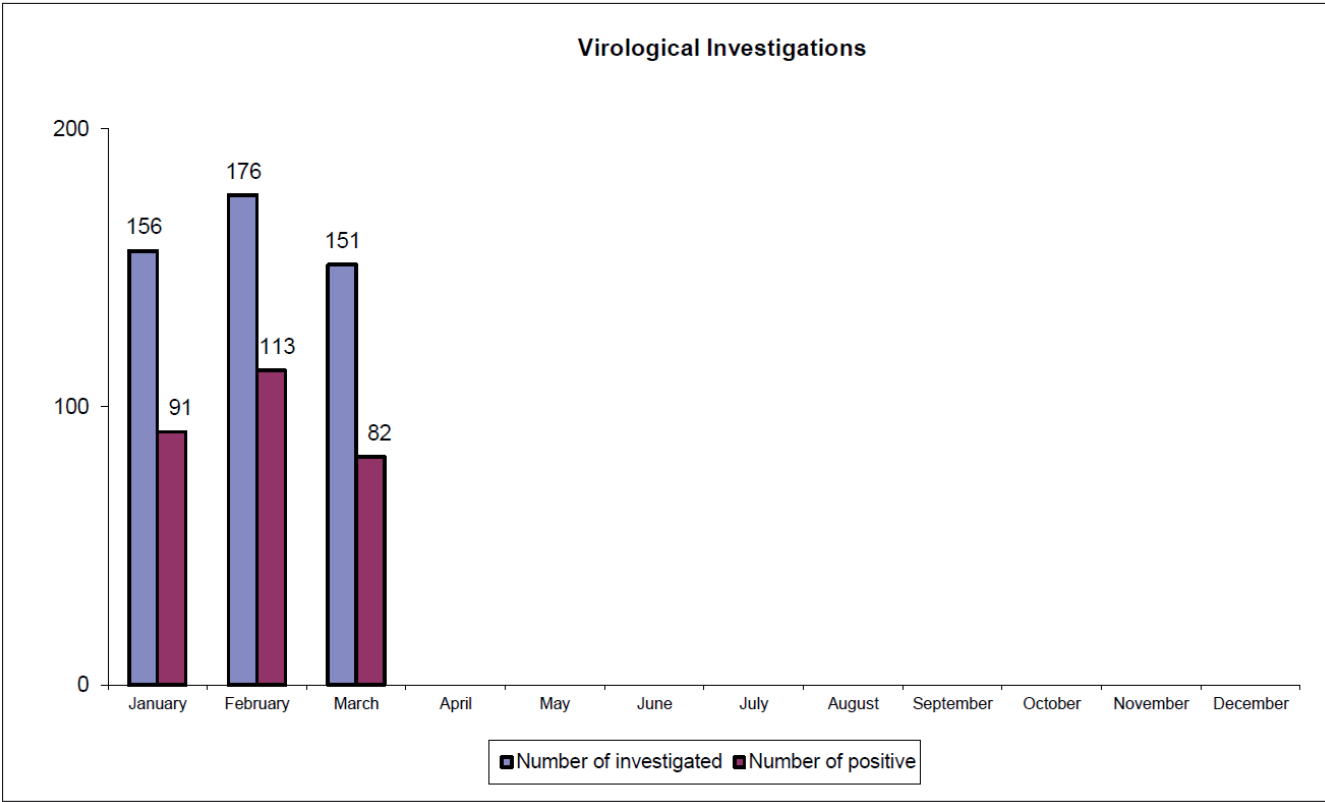


Geographical distribution of samples submitted for ASFV investigation in wild boars in Slovakia during 2022 (January - March) - passive surveillance

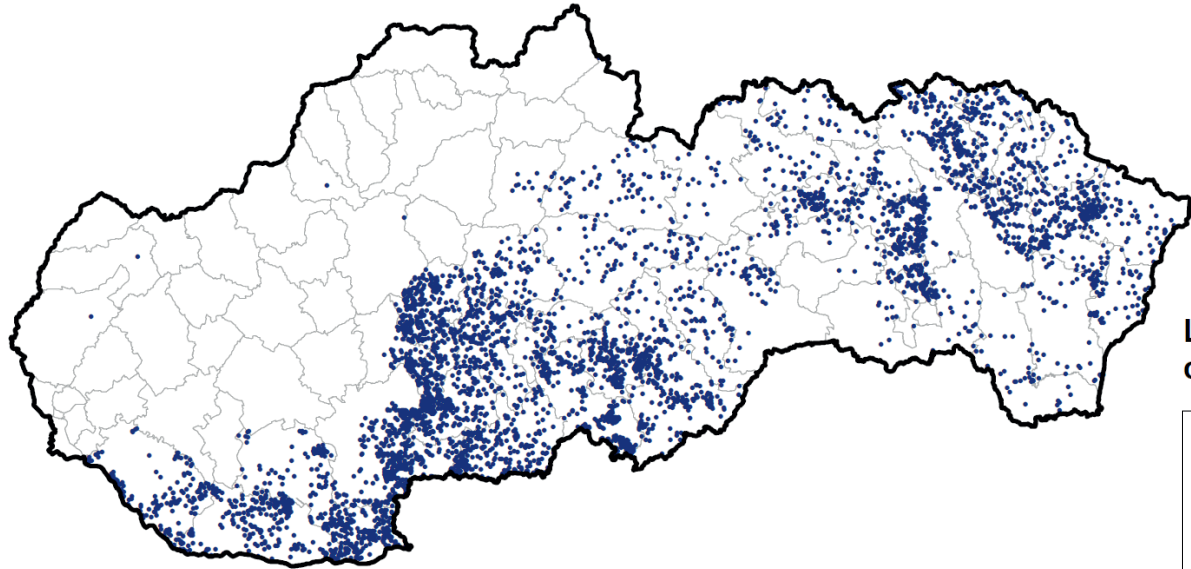

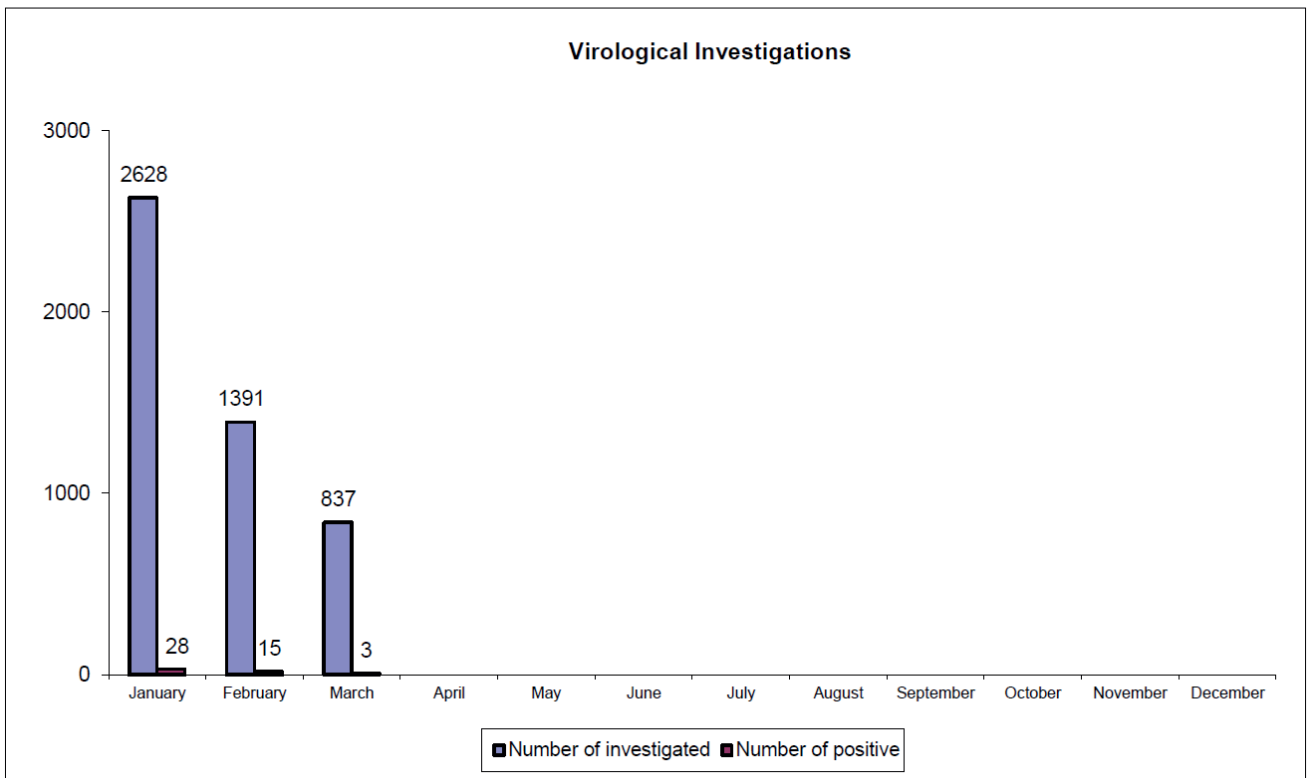


Geographical distribution of samples submitted for ASFV investigation in wild boars in Slovakia during 2022 (January - March) - active surveillance

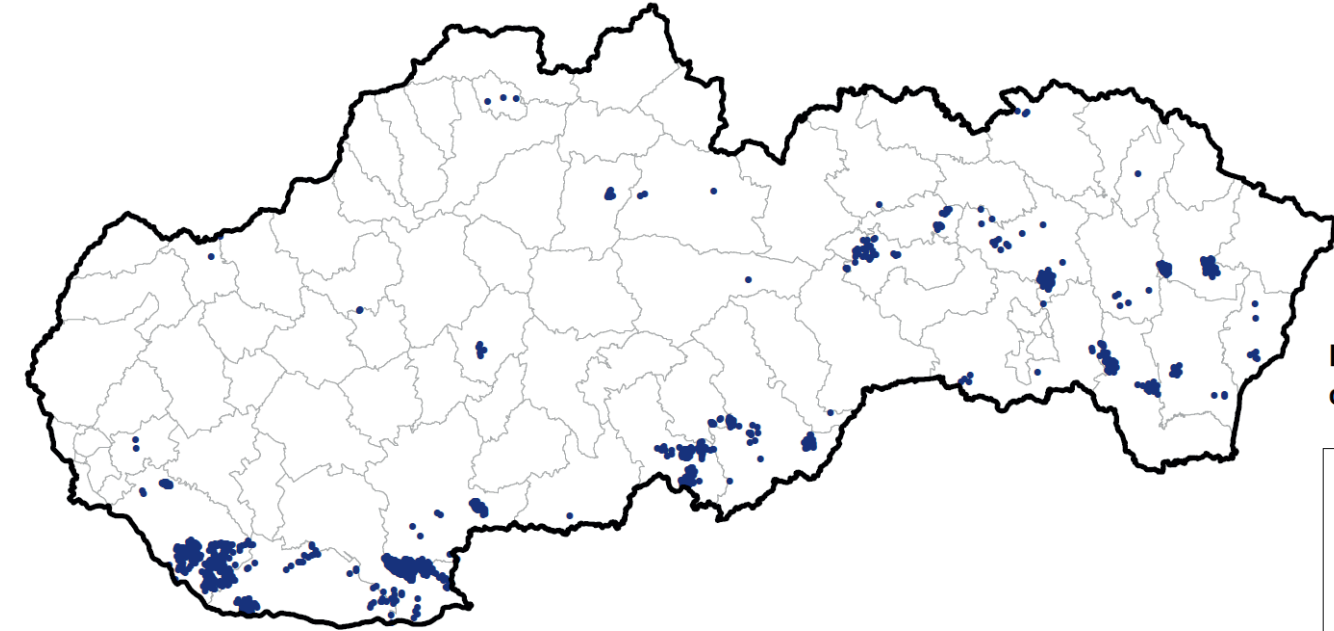

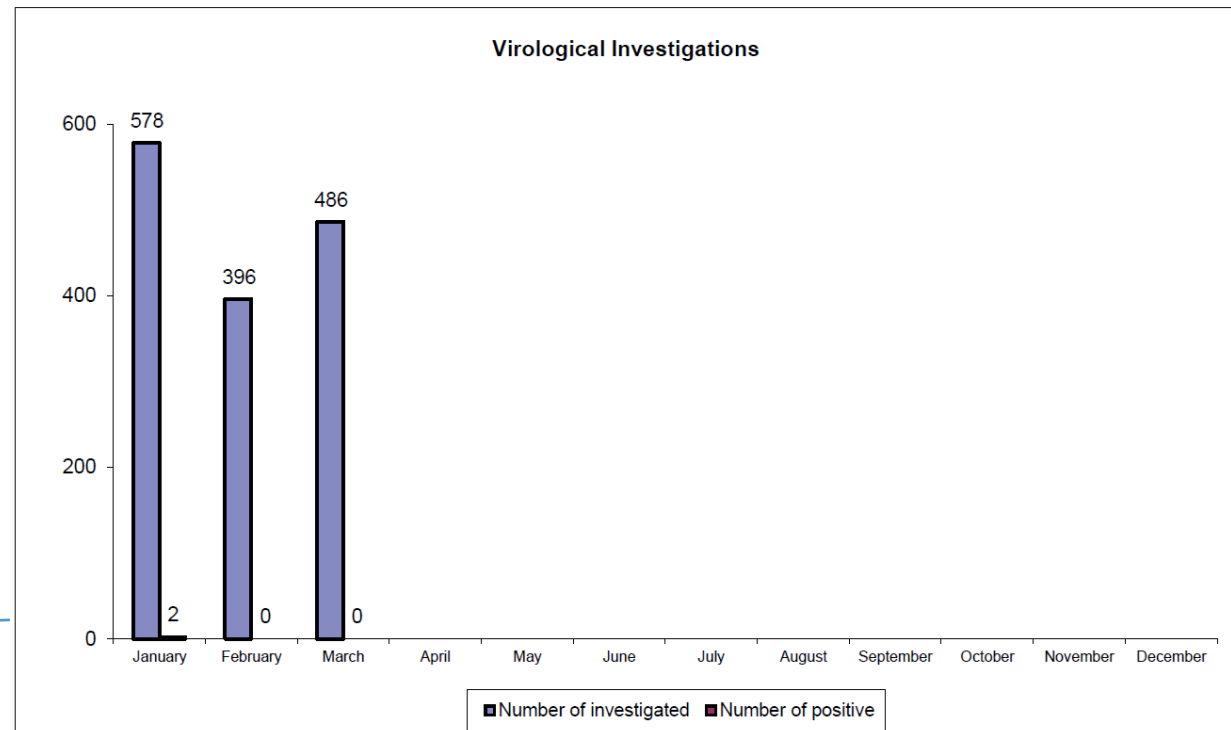


Geographical distribution of samples submitted for ASF investigation in domestic swine in Slovakia during 2022 (January - March)

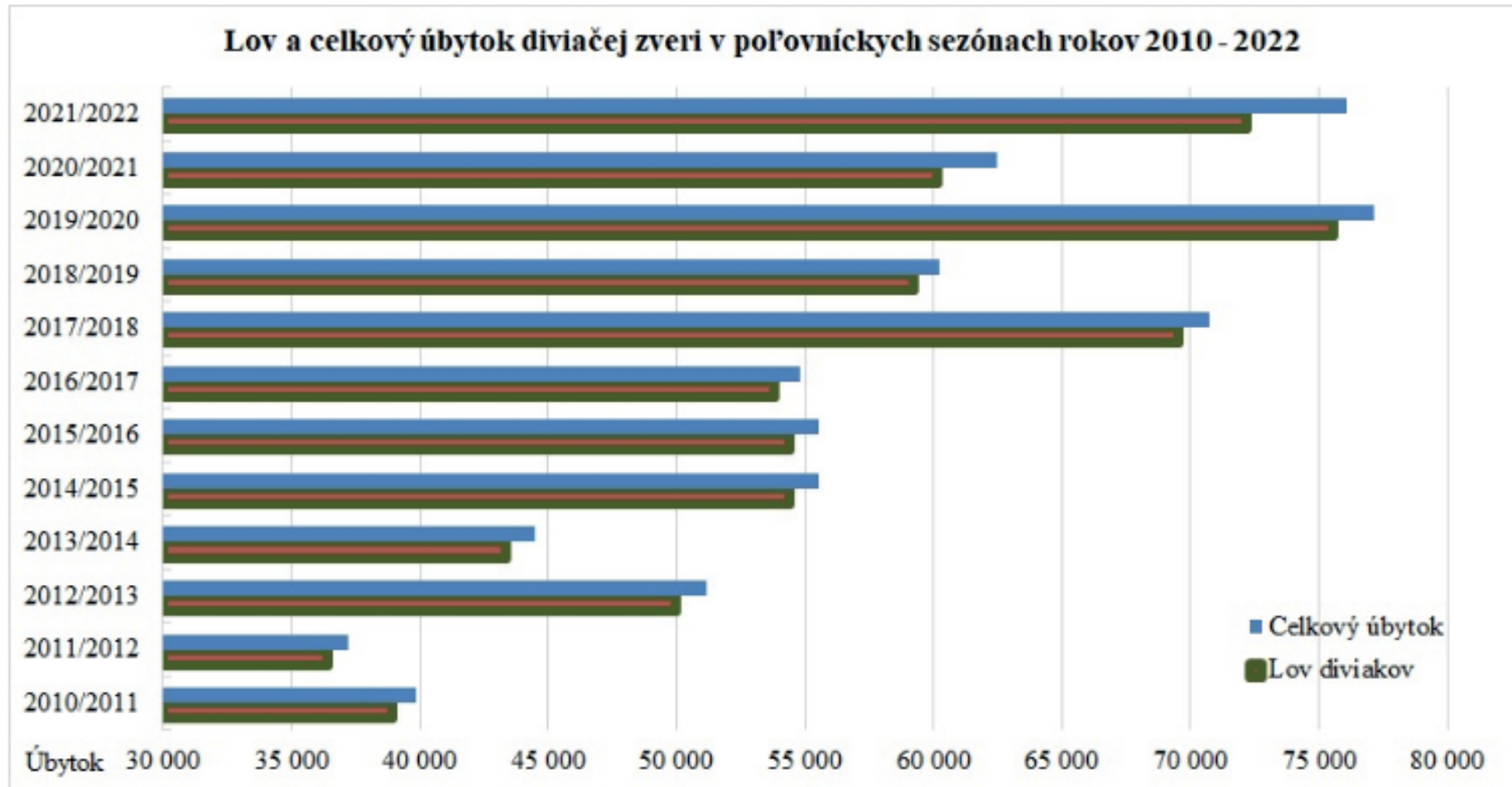

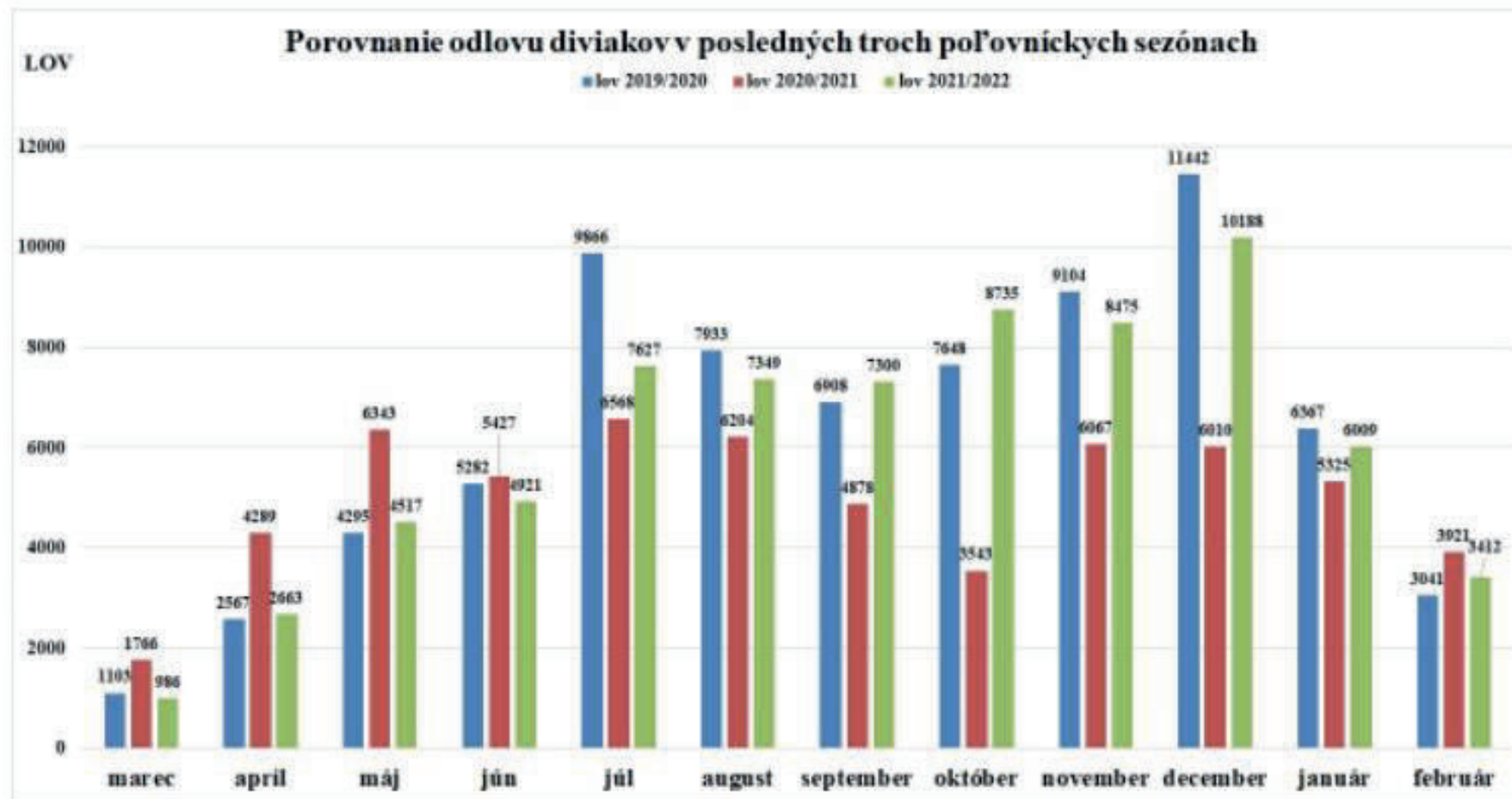
Laboratory Investigations of ASF in domestic pigs in Slovakia during 2022 (January - March)

Summary – ASF /SK 05.04.2022

- **No further suspicions in domestic pigs (for the time being)**
- **Situation in WB – more less stabilised- further spread within expected „borders“- within already affected regions**
- All protection zones and surveillance zones related to outbreaks confirmed in autumn/winter 2021/2022 according to CR 2020/687 – lifted
- Veterinary measures according the Regulation 2021/605 in place
- ASF positive WB – one enlargement of part II in infected region Banská Bystrica and Liptovský Mikuláš an-update of the regionalisation related to ASF- measures for hunting grounds newly ordered/issues incl. Temporary ban of hunting
- Controls of biosecurity WB/domestic – in progress
- ASF issue (incl. proper implementation of the measures ordered) will be a part of meeting with official veterinarians organised by central veterinary authority on 4.5.2022
