Background:

Commission's AMR (antimicrobial resistance) road map and action plan:

- strengthening regulatory framework for veterinary medicinal products (VMPs) and medicated feed
- recommendations for prudent use of antimicrobials
- (parallel SANTE Directorate C activities concerning prudent use of antimicrobials in humans)





Aims of FVO project:

- Examine how Member States (MS) ensure that the relevant legal requirements (availability, distribution and use of antimicrobials) are respected
- To assess the implementation of national and <u>EU</u> <u>guidance</u> (<u>published 11-9-15</u>) on prudent use especially for critically important antimicrobials (CIAs), and
- To identify and disseminate best practices implemented by the MS





Approach:

- Questionnaire to all MS (plus Iceland, Norway and Switzerland), distributed to:
 - Competent Authorities (CAs) and
- stakeholders (Advisory Group and national FVE member organisations)
- Draft questionnaire prepared:
 - Aiming to be straightforward, comprehensive but not too onerous....
 - Avoiding a legalistic approach
- Comments on draft questionnaire invited from AMR WG members after meeting of 1-7-15



Distribution of questionnaire August 2015:

- Questionnaire finalised taking into account comments received from AMR WG members
- Questionnaire send to MS CAs (competent authorities), plus IS, NO and CH
- CAs were free to consult with national stakeholders in compiling their responses
- EU stakeholders consulted via Advisory Group on the Food Chain and Animal and Plant Health (email on 12 August, reminder e-mail 19 October)
- FVE national member organisations also consulted to facilitate responses from veterinary organisations



Responses to questionnaire:

- Requested to be submitted by 16 November 2015
- By e-mail to the address sante-fvo-inspections@ec.europa.eu
- Using the reference "prudent use project"
- It would be greatly appreciated if responses were submitted in English





Subsequent steps:

- Series of FVO <u>fact-finding</u> missions to be performed in 9 Member States during 2016 (proposed to be DK, DE, ES, SI, NL, RO, CZ, CY, FI, as discussed at CVO meeting in FVO June 2015)
- Selected on basis of:
 - Published data (e.g. ESVAC, published guidelines)
 - Internal information available to Commission
 - Geographical spread etc.





Outcome of overall project:

- Individual reports of fact-finding missions will be published on FVO website, following that MS commenting on the draft FVO report as normal
- Individual reports won't contain any recommendations
- Final overview report will also be published on FVO website- summarising key findings of questionnaire responses, desk study and factfinding missions
