



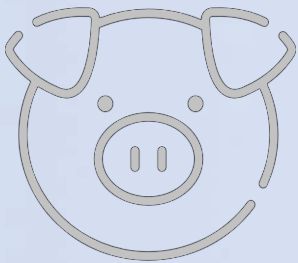

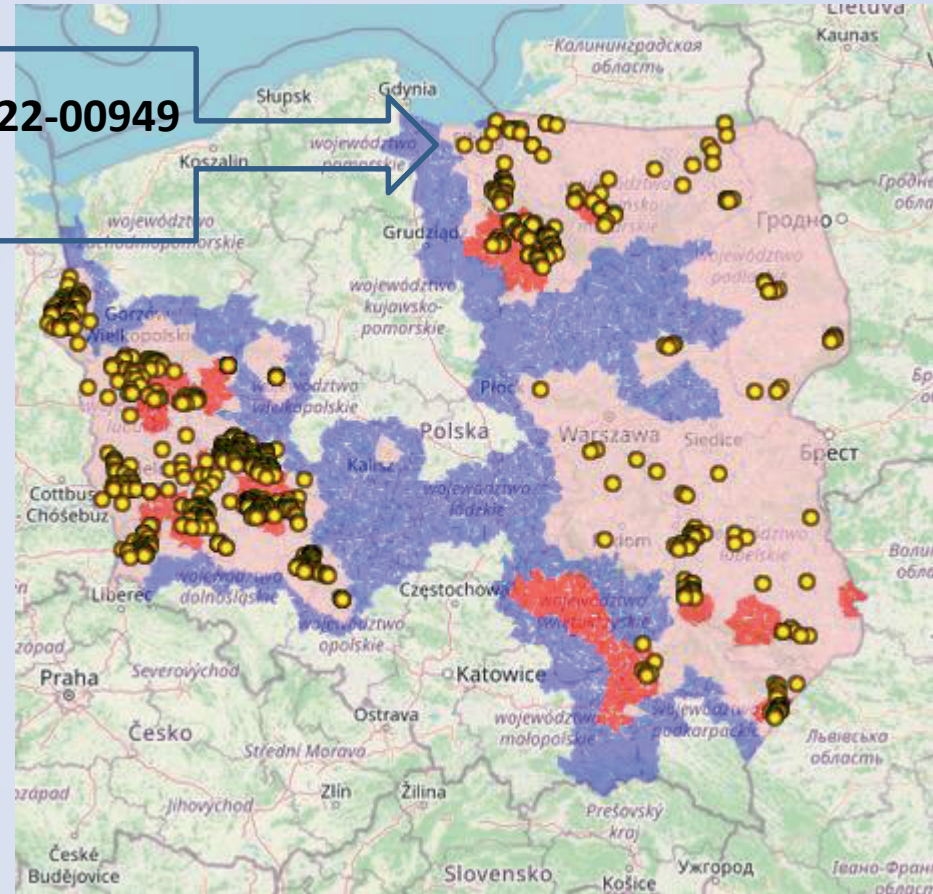


Amendments of regionalisation

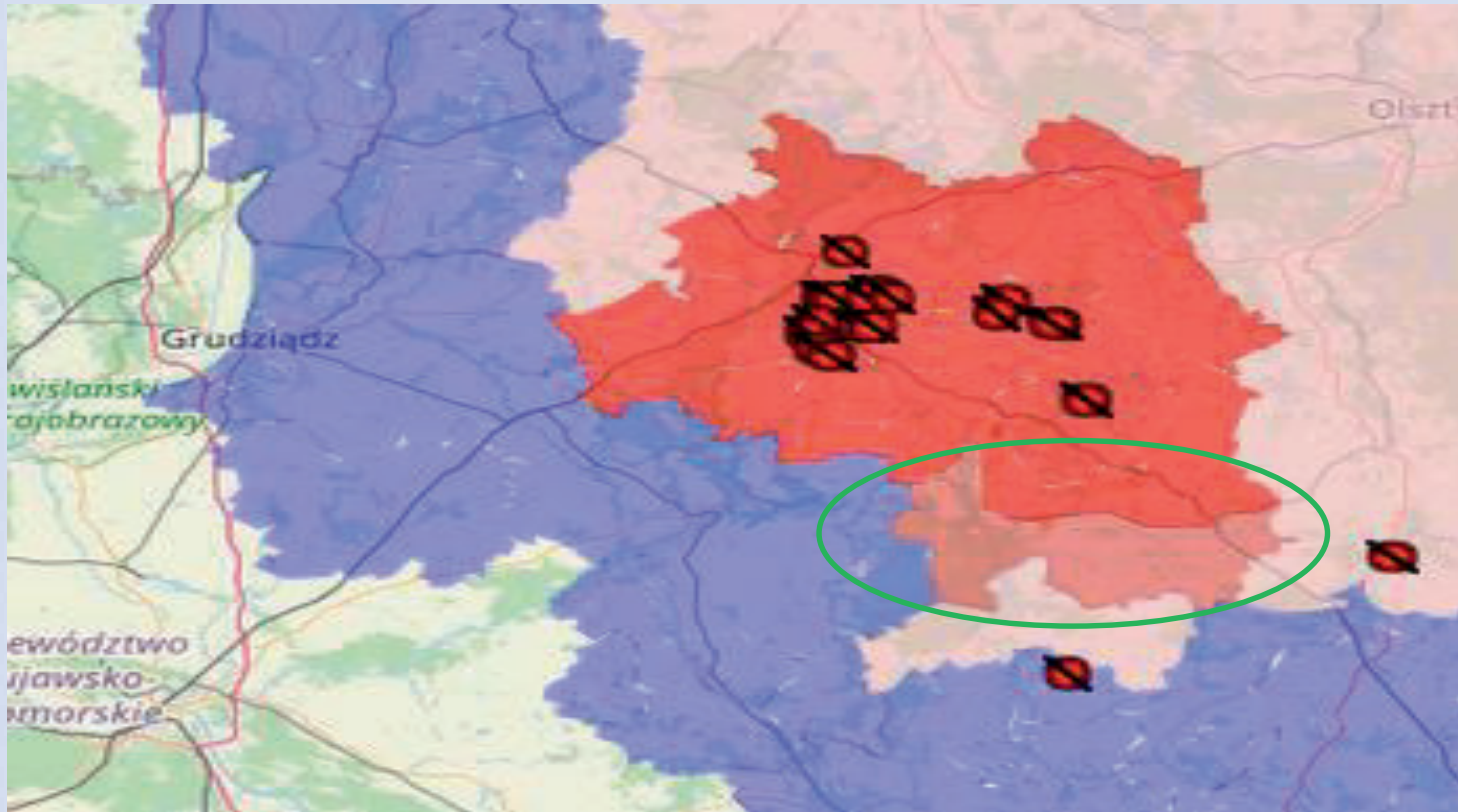
WB shot in RZ II, 12 months

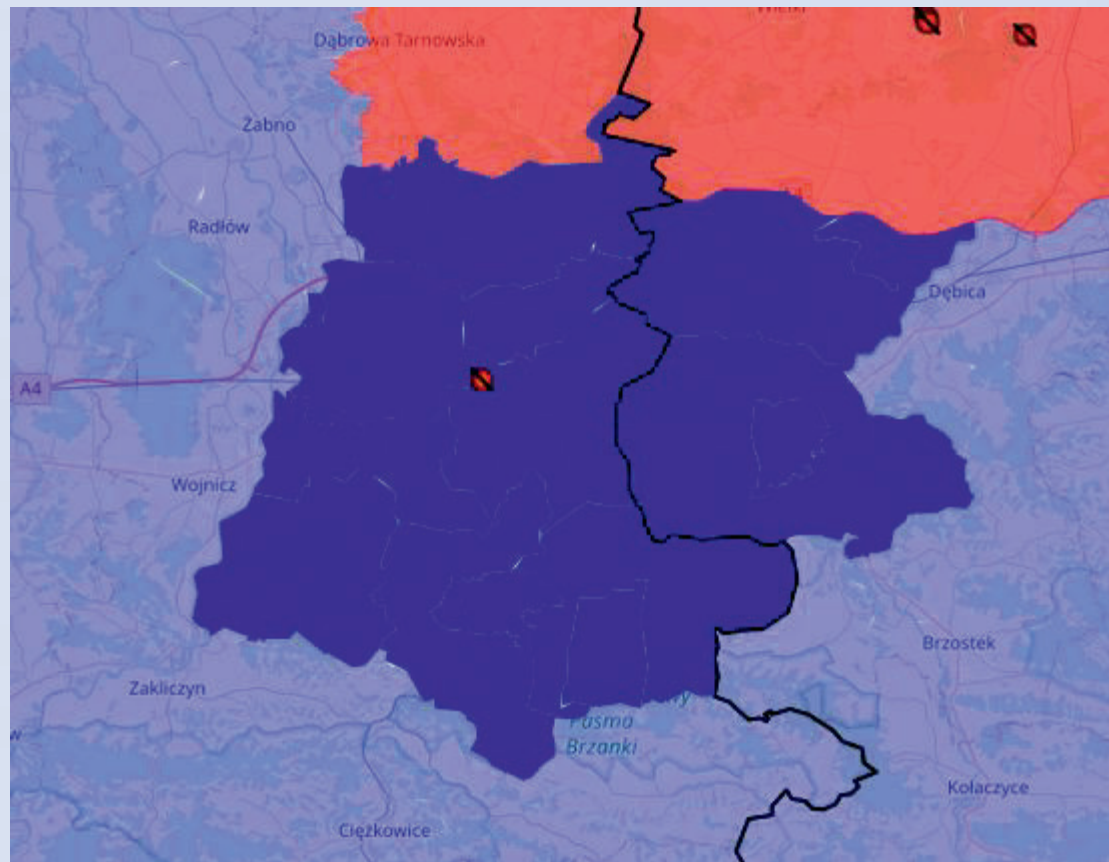
1. Warmińsko – Mazurskie region – reversion RZ III =>RZ II



Amendments of regionalisation



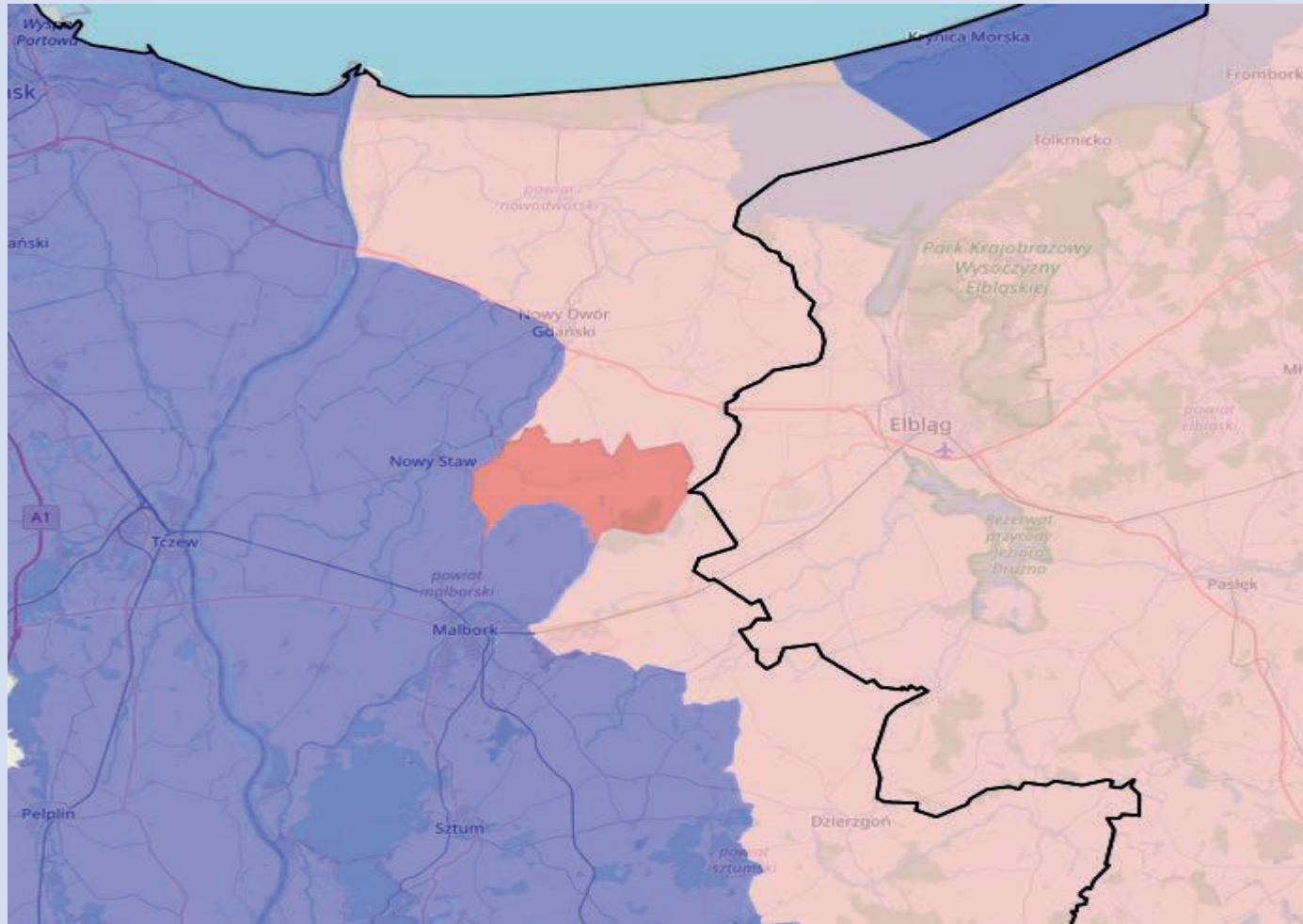
2. Podkarpackie and Małopolskie region – reversion RZ III =>RZ I

Bilateral cooperation of German and Polish Veterinary Authorities

Current activities:



- exchange of information of current epidemiological situation in both countries,
- measures to eradicate and prevent the spread of ASF,
- exchange and use of experiences, i. e. implementation of wild boar search by trained dogs in Poland
- actions on removal of wild boar carcasses from the environment,
- management of the wild boar population,
- disposal of carcasses of shot and found dead wild boar



Joint evaluation and adaptation of activities after
EUVET missions in both countries:



- It was agreed to sign a memorandum of cooperation between Germany and Poland,
- It was agreed to continue joint simulation exercises that were stopped due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic,
- The need to integrate the institutions responsible for hunting in both countries was established,
- The interest in conducting joint activities at a technical level was expressed , e.g. drone flights to assess the wild boar population on both sides of the border,
- the need to exchange information on technical resources that can be used in the fight against ASF was recognized, e.g. information on rendering plants.
- Knowledge exchange of NRLs

Future endeavours:



- Next CVO meeting in Berlin in the next few months; signing a memorandum of cooperation and regular bilateral exchanges between Germany and Poland
- Establishment of better communication structure and an information format to exchange current measures
- Naming of contact points for the National Reference Laboratories
