Establishment nr. 1 – origin

Gătaia Nouă – Timiș county

19.04 - 22.04.2021:

- mortalities: 55 breeding sows without clinical signs;
- necropsies: 17 dead sows;
- first positive test: 19.04;
- confirmation on 20.04.2021

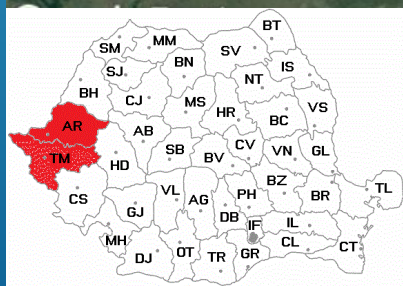
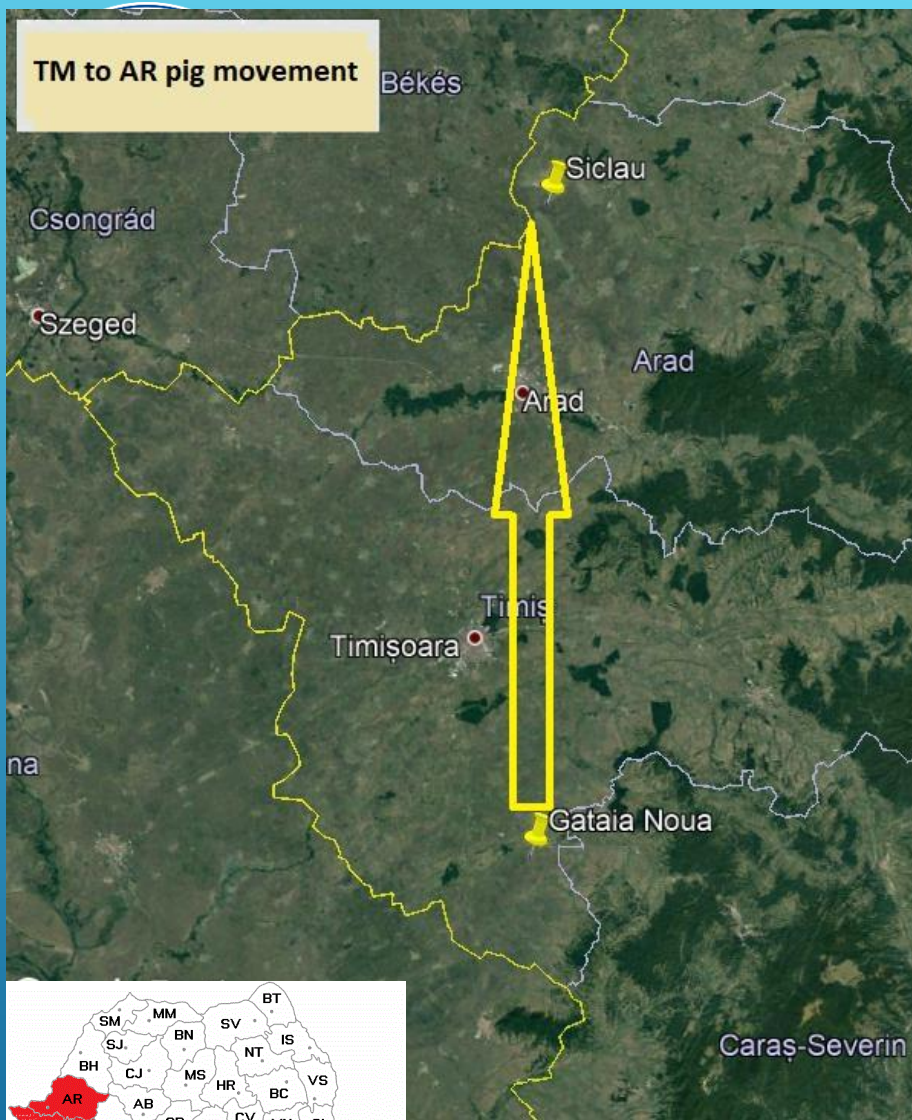
Establishment nr. 2 – destination

Șiclău – Arad county

19.04 - 22.04.2021:

- first positive test: 19.04;
- confirmation on 21.04.2021;
- possible date of entry of the virus into the holding: 15.04.2021

The epidemiological investigation is ongoing



Establishment nr. 1 – origin Gătaia Nouă – Timiș county

- at the time of transport was not included in a restricted zone (protection or surveillance);
- passive surv. (02.03 – 19.04.2021): virological examination 18 sets of organs (2 sets per week); until 19.04.2021 all the tests were neg.
- period of transport: 03 -17.04.2021;
- nr. of pigs transported to Șiclău farm: 16.205 piglets(1-2 month)

Establishment nr. 2 – destination Șiclău – Arad county

- at the time of transport was not included in a restricted zone (protection or surveillance);
- Before movement, was under restriction 19.08.2020-04.03.2021
- at the time of transport, empty since 12.03.2021;

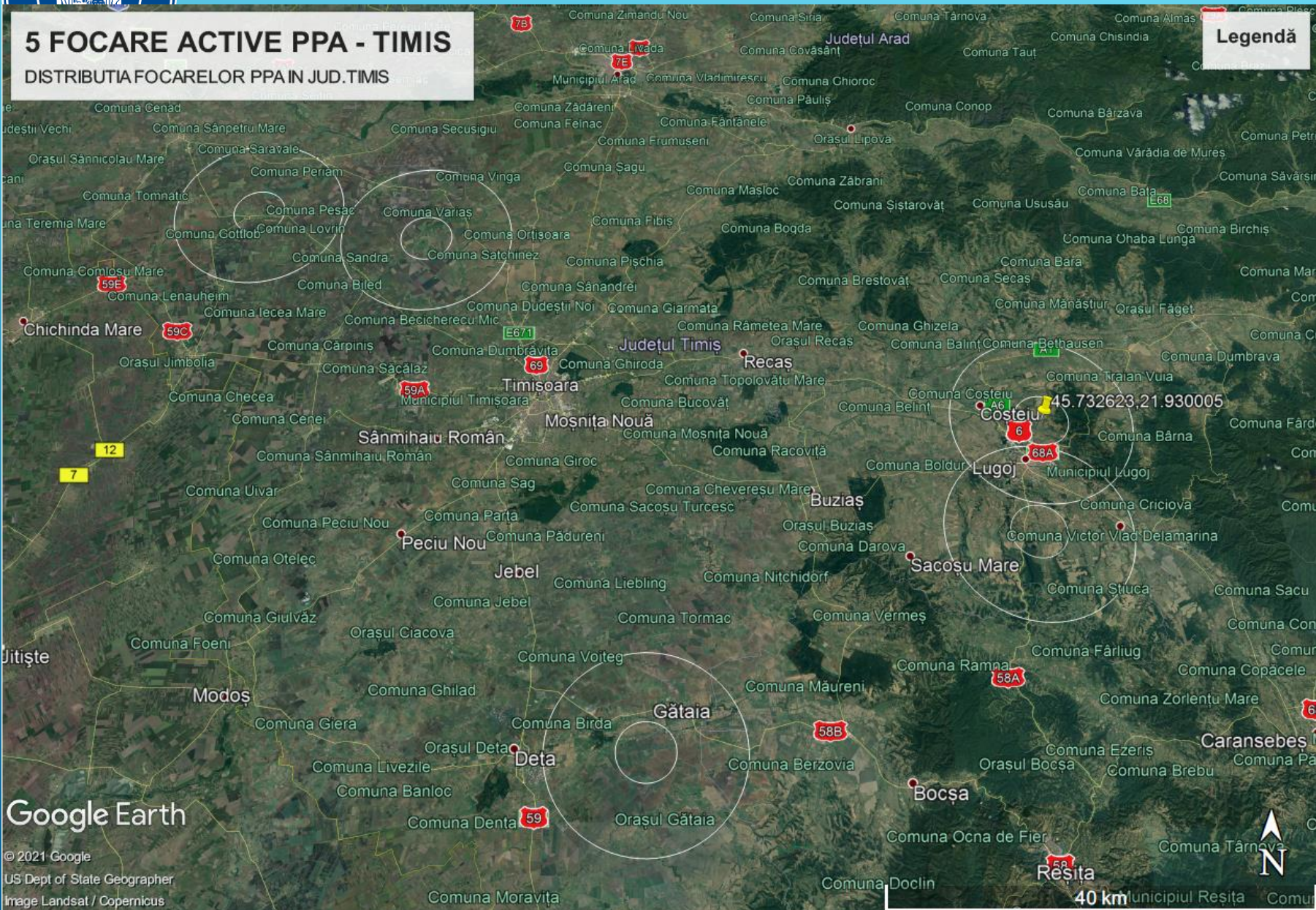


Timiș county ASF epidemiological situation

- Signed by NSVFSA, sent for approval to the other ministries;
- Will be presented and adopted by the National Disease Control Center;
- The final form will be adopted by parliament.
