	Art 65.6: Intensified controls	
1	COM presented a draft implementing regulation. MS asked for clarifications and made several suggestions. More specifically,	
	the discussion revolved around matters such as the criteria for the Commission's assessment of notified infringements and the timeframe for its actions. Also the need for informing third countries at an early stage, and the need for certain flexibility as regards the total target weight of the successfully checked consignments, were discussed.	Draft document shared with Member States ahead of the meeting
	COM provided several clarifications on the points raised by the MS and took note of the MS suggestions. A revised version of the draft will be sent to MS within shortly, in view of their written comments by the end of November and a further discussion at the meeting on 5 th December.	
	Art 77.3 a: Specific official controls (certificates)	
2	COM presented a draft implementing regulation.	
	MS asked for clarifications and made several suggestions as to simplify the procedures and the certificates. MS indicated that some information required in the forms could not be provided and particular stages and for this reason the modalities of signing certain documents would need to be clarified. COM provided several clarifications on the points raised by the MS and took note of the MS suggestions. COM invited the MS to submit written comments on the draft by 21 November 2018.
