2. Adoption of the minutes of the previous meeting of the sub-Committee

3. Declarations of interest

4. Discussion and possible approval of reports of the Sub-Committee

(i) The effects of using Bovine Somatotrophin.

The sub committee completed its detailed examination of the draft report and agreed several changes to the text. The sub committee approved the document which will now go forward to the Scientific Committee on Animal Health and Animal Welfare for discussion and possible adoption at its meeting on 10 March 1999.

(ii) Standards for forced ventilation for animal transport vehicles for journeys of more than eight hours for the bovine, porcine, ovine and caprine species

The working document was briefly discussed and the general principles were agreed. It was decided to hold a drafting meeting in April to finalise the text in advance of the next sub committee meeting.

The representatives of DGVI also requested that the Committee expand the question addressed in order to include the ventilation requirements on animal transport vehicles while they are stationary e.g. an overnight stop. The subcommittee agreed to examine this issue with a view to possibly including it in the present report.
