# ADIS

- Now have access 111 users from national CA of 23 MS and 4 third countries.
- List of main known priority issues that should be solved in further release:
  1. automatic data import into ADIS (by excel and webservice) not yet operational
  2. emails are not sent to self (who does the notification does not receive an email)
  3. data extraction ok (capped to excel limit of 65k lines) - same for the map.
  4. serotypes are in the database but are not displayed in ADIS Excel extraction tool. E.g. HPAI or BT
  5. link between tests and disease is in the process of being finalised
  6. dates (e.g. date of confirmation) are registered ok, but the display show a date earlier in time (1 day earlier)

# ADIS – in the pipeline

1. add a map in the weekly email
2. group outbreak email
3. translation
4. show changes in modified outbreak email
5. dashboard --> release 2
6. possibility to make outbreaks in the sea --> release 2

As you know the new **Animal Health Law** will enters into application on the **21/04/2021**.  
ADNS will be replaced by ADIS.  
As of **20/04/2021 17:00** it will not be possible to enter new outbreaks anymore in ADNS.  
Although all ADNS outbreaks will be imported in ADIS, the ADNS system will remain open a few months for consultation purposes only.  
ADIS will be open from the 21st of April in the morning. <https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/tracesnt>  
It will be possible to view and update old outbreaks imported from ADNS but following the mandatory fields of the new system.  
ADIS key users will be contacted by [SANTE ADIS SUPPORT](mailto:SANTE_ADIS_SUPPORT) few days before the launch of ADIS to activate their account and appoint the required national users.
