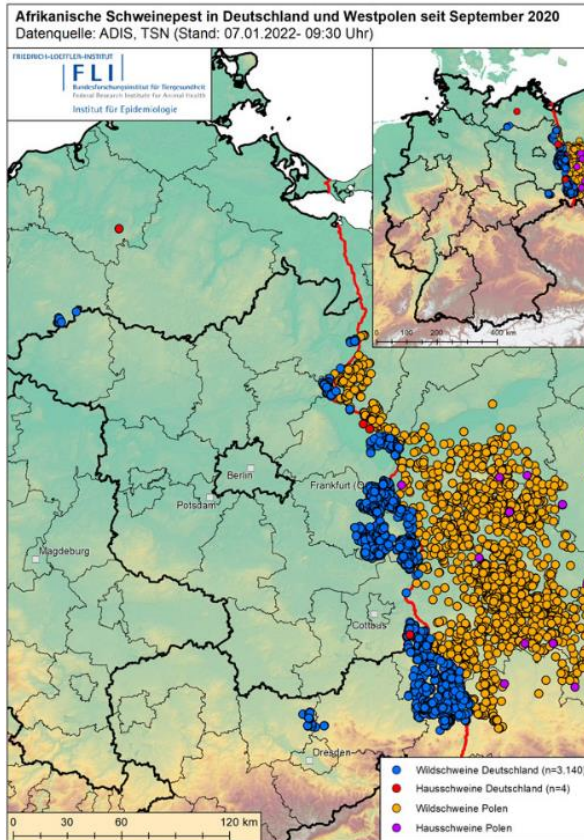

ASF – MV: domestic pigs

ASF in a fattening farm (4.000 fattening places)

- stamping out and disposal of the cadavers
- preliminary cleaning and disinfection
- control of insects and rodents
- sampling of wild boars
- mobile fence
- ban on movement of wild boars and wild boar meat/products
- active search for carcasses/
- intensified hunting



ASF – MV: domestic pigs

ASF in a fattening farm (4.000 fattening places)

Protection zone:

all establishments have been visited by OV

Clinical examination of domestic pigs

Samples taken: all ASF-negative



Surveillance zone:

Control measures in place (Regulation 2020/687 Article 40-54)

Representative number of establishments have been visited by OV

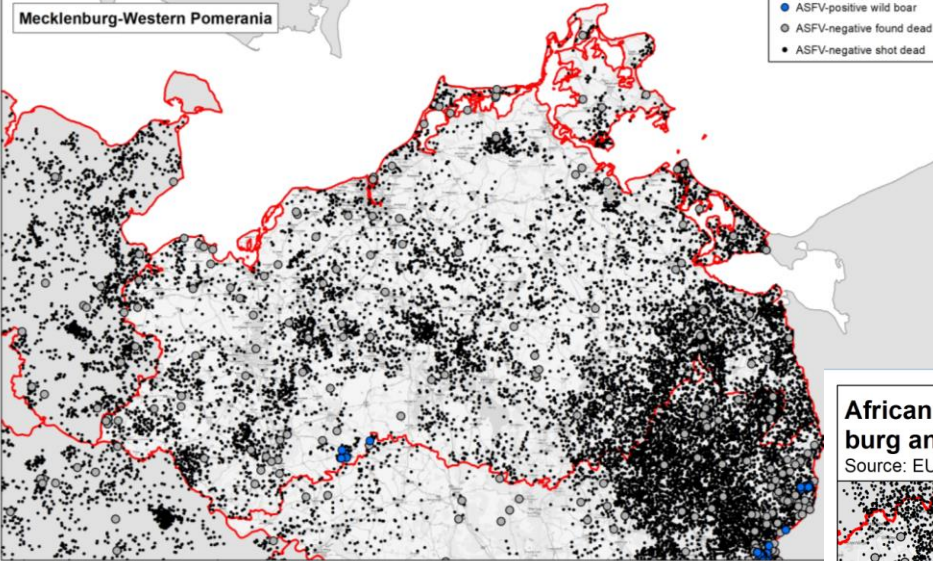

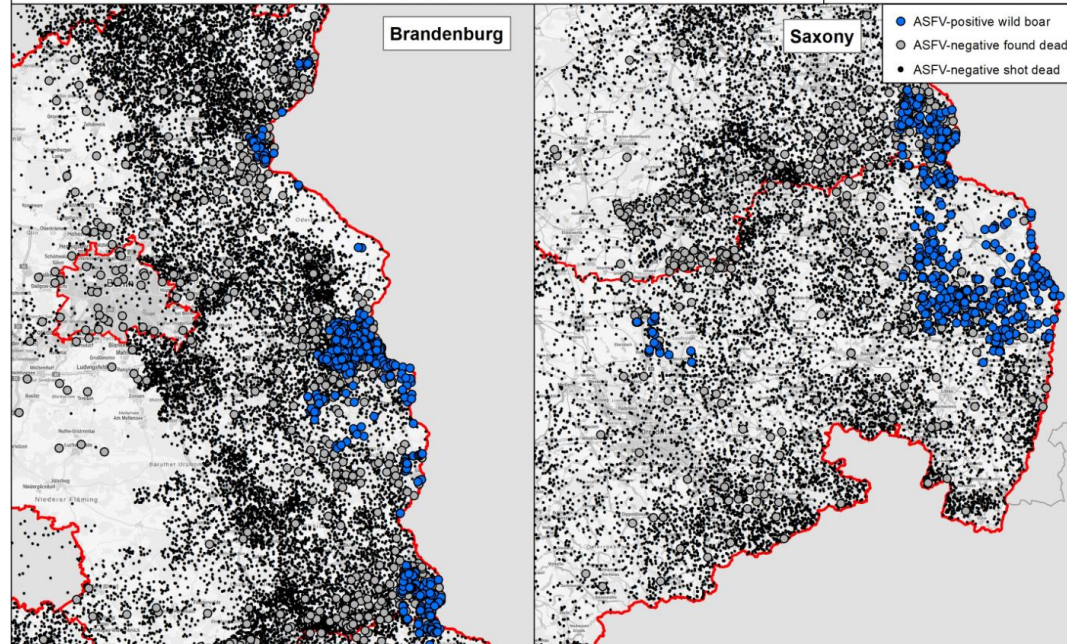
