



New restocking proposal in FRZ (Orange zone): what is changing



- It is allowed restocking in holdings which have been site of confirmed outbreaks, in accordance to articles 48 and 49 of Legislative Decree 9/2010 (restocking specific measures)
- Restocking of broilers and turkeys in FRZ is prohibited
 - Same derogation's criteria to be applied in broiler and turkeys farms as in the Ministerial Provision n. 2798 on 02/02/2022 (distance and homogeneus areas)
- Restocking of pullets/laying hens and breeding animals (chickens and laying)

It is possible if:

- biosecurity measures are respected and have been verified by the veterinary service in the last 12 months
- prior communication to the Regions (which can deny the authorization in specific situation)
- Regions, supported by the opinion of Ministry of Health and NRC-IA, will assess specific situation, in which derogation's criteria are not applicable.



New restocking proposal in «attention Zone» (green zone): what is changing



- Restocking is allowed if biosecurity measures are respected and have been verified by the veterinary service in the last 12 months
- Movements (except for broiler) in both FRZ and green zone:
 - <u>To Slaughter</u> -> after clinic visit and virological testing 24 hours before the start of pre-loading, repeated every 48 hours until loading ends
 - <u>To live</u> -> after clinic visit 24 hours before the start of pre-loading and virological testing 48 hours before, repeated every 48 hours until loading ends





Reinforcement of wild birds passive surveillance



- No later than 30/05, the Ministry of Health will adopt a National Surveillance Plan for wild birds
- Active partecipation of Associations, Local Authorities and services, Police, Bodies etc
- Objectives: to strengthen the existing passive surveillance system and identify areas of high risk HPAI introduction
 - Regions:
 - In 2022 strengthening of the existing Surveillance Plan as in the NSP for Al
 - State-Regions Agreement to update risk zones
