The EUMS have the following comments:

Template for sampling plans

The EUMS recall that CCMAS38 offered to develop a template, which will provide guidance to commodity committees when developing sampling plans. As this work is still ongoing in CCMAS, the EUMS agree that no action is needed by CCPFV.

Quick frozen French fried potatoes - method for free fatty acids

The EUMS agree with the recommendation of the EWG and would suggest that CCPFV withdraws the requirements for FFA analysis in quick-frozen French-fried potatoes. In case this is accepted by the CCPFV, no method of analysis associated to this provision needs to be identified and forwarded to CCMAS for endorsement.
