Model Memorandum

between the Federal Service for Veterinary and Phytosanitary Surveillance of the Russian Federation and the Competent Authority of, responsible for the safety of exported aquatic biological resources and products of their processing, on conditions for deliveries of fish, fishery products and seafood from to the Russian Federation

In the framework of the Memorandum of 2 September 2004 between the European Community and the Russian Federation on veterinary certification of animals and animal products to be exported from the EC to Russia and in order to control effectively deliveries of fish, fishery products and seafood from to the Russian Federation, the Federal Service for Veterinary and Phytosanitary Surveillance (Rosselkhoznadzor) of the Russian Federation and the Competent Authority of, responsible for the safety of exported aquatic biological resources and products of their processing have agreed on the following administrative measures:

- 1. Fish, fishery products and seafood may only originate from catching, processing establishments (vessels) and cold stores approved by Rosselkhoznadzor for export to the Russian Federation. Taking into account the fact that in establishments for the production and storage have never been attested, the Competent Authority of will draw up a list of the above mentioned establishments that have been delivering their products to the Russian market or have requests from Russian importers.
- Competent Authority of, when placing an establishment on the list, guarantees that the establishment complies with the Russian veterinary and sanitary requirements.
- 3. Deliveries of fish, fishery products and seafood from to the Russian Federation will be carried out from the moment of signing of the present memorandum only directly from the establishments appearing on the above list without intermediate storing and splitting of shipments after their final certification.
- 4. The Competent Authority of guarantees that fish, fishery products and seafood manufactured at establishments and exported from to the Russian Federation fulfil the Russian veterinary and sanitary requirements in conformity with the Memorandum of 2004. The Competent Authority of will take all necessary measures to prevent possible deliveries to the territory of the Russian Federation of fish, fishery products and seafood which do not fulfil those requirements.
- 5. The Competent Authority of will communicate to Rosselkhoznadzor any updates to the lists of establishments, approved by Rosselkhoznadzor. The administrative approval of the establishments comes into force not later than 30 days after the submission of the updated list, if Rosselkhoznadzor have not expressed their objection within this time period. The approval becomes effective within two weeks after the administrative approval, in order to allow Rosselkhoznadzor to inform the Russian Federation border control posts.
- The Competent Authority of is responsible for the regular supervision of the approved establishments (vessels) to ensure that the relevant veterinary and sanitary requirements are constantly met. If in the context of this supervision it
