# Results of the implementation of Rabies co-financed eradication program in Latvia during 2015

PAFF meeting, Brussels, 5-6 July 2016.



## **Territory and borders of Latvia**

Total area: 64 635 km<sup>2</sup>

Latvia lies on the Eastern coast of the Baltic Sea.

The length of sea border is 494 km.

The total length of terrestrial borders is 1862 km.



#### Terrestrial borders with:

Estonia - 343 km

Russia - 282 km

Belarus – 167 km


Lithuania - 576 km



#### Rabies cases in Latvia 1990-2015

The last rabies cases was confirmed in February 2012.


Latvia is free from rabies since December 2014 (OIE self-declaration)





## Rabies passive surveillance 2015

Passive surveillance – all suspected animals (wildlife + domestic) submitted to National Reference laboratory for testing to rabies virus.






#### Wildlife oral vaccination in 2015

Due to favorable rabies epidemiological situation vaccination area is reduced to 25 600 km<sup>2</sup> since 2014.

- Two vaccination campaigns
- Distance between flight lines 500m
- ~25 baits/km<sup>2</sup>
- Each vaccine bait distributed is registered.



1 280 000 Lysvulpen (Bioveta) vaccine baits were distributed during spring and autumn vaccination campaigns. Vaccination was performed from aircrafts Cessna 172 using fully automatic vaccine distribution registration and control device SURVIS.



# Monitoring results of vaccination campaigns

To ensure vaccination efficiency control - hunted foxes and raccoon dogs from vaccinated area were purchased from hunters and submitted to NRL for testing to bait uptake (LM) and seroconversion (ELISA).

Summary: 70% of tested animals have antibodies against rabies virus




#### Rabies programme in the Belarus in 2015

Since 2012 EU co-financed program includes oral vaccination of wildlife (foxes and raccoon dogs) in Belarus territory near Latvia (EU Eastern border) to establish approximately 50 km buffer zone

with total area of **10 850** km<sup>2</sup>.

- Implementation of the program ensured by Food and Veterinary Department of Belarus
- Two vaccination campaigns performed
- 500 000 vaccine baits were distributed.





# Financial aspects 2015

Total eligible costs of implementation of 2015 rabies eradication program - 1 347 742.84 EUR:

- •in Latvia 936 343.10 EUR
- •in Belarus 411 399.74 EUR
