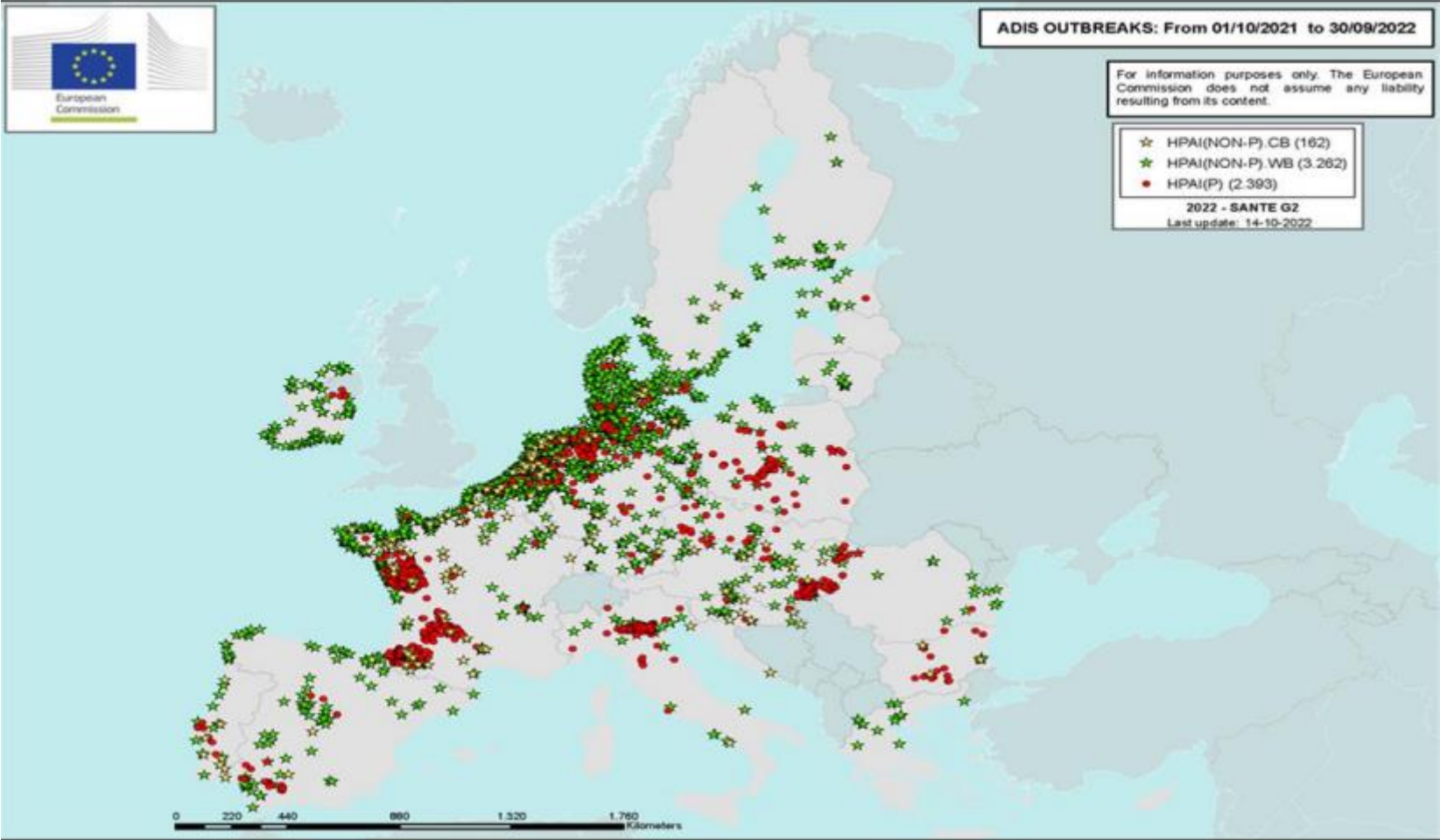

Based on the risk assessment the competent authority decided not to apply restrictions in the area around the affected establishment. However, visits to selected poultry farms located in that area will be carried out by the official veterinarians.
