


General Conditions and time period of distribution

- HR total surface: 56.542 km²
 - Distribution area on 53.317 km² (islands excluded)
- OVF 2 campaigns/Year
 - spring 23 May 29 May 2018
 - autumn 26 September 2018 till 03 October 2018
- Bait density = 25 baits/km²
 - Total No baits distributed/campaign 1.332.925
- Distribution by plane
 - manual distribution option in legislation but not used
- Flight line distance: 500m
 - 2 parallel flight lines / km²
- 2011 2019 (according to latest tender in 2018) Vaccine SAD Bern strain (Lysvulpen Bioveta CZ)

 and Flight lines






OVF MONITORING


- Sample: fox and jackal carcass (certain counties)
- No of samples: 4 animals/100km²
 - A sample size set for each hunting ground in order to avoid bias in results.
 - Up-to-date information on hunting grounds and size of their concession areas are given by Directorate of Forestry, Hunting and Wood Industry
- Total NO of samples to be tested/year: <u>2179</u>
 - 2072 foxes
 - 191 jackal
- Guidance on the manner of animal health control measures
 prescribes:
 - Obligation of hunters related to No of samples /hunting ground that must be shoot and delivered to AVO for the purpose of monitoring
 - Obligation of AVO related to control of samples, submission of samples to laboratory
 - Financial aspects
 - Laboratories included in monitoring

OVF MONITORING RESULTS 2018

- FAT Total No tested 805 / Total No positive 0
 - Fox 786
 - Jackal 19




- OTC Total No tested/positive 797/684 = 85,82%
 - o Foxes 779/669
 - 85,87 % OTC positive
 - o Jackal 18/15
 - 83,33 % OTC positive




mFAVN testing results 2018

- Total No mFAVN tested/positive
- Foxes 757/123
 - 16,24 % mFAVN positive



SURVEILLANCE

- Order on measures to protect animals from infectious and parasitic diseases and the financing in 2018
- Active
 - All foxes and golden jackals regularly shoot in 2018/805
 - Fox 786
 - Jackal 19
- Passive
 - Clinical suspicions & Animals found dead (road kills, hunting grounds, holding, pasture);
 - o total No tested :
 - Wildlife 193
 - Domestic 107
 - Clinical suspicion 98



CONTROL OF IMPLEMENTATION

MAIN WEAK POINTS NOTICED 2018

- No of required foxes per hunting ground (4 foxes/100 km²)
 - Insufficient No of samples in 2018 (only 36.94% of requested)
 - Possibly due to "low" financial reword for hunters (13Euro/fox ;33Euro/jackal) and perception that there is no risk from rabies any more
 - Inadequate age of animals (majority probably under 1 y old)
 - No samples from southern counties
 - Lower interest of hunters from southern parts of the country to sent samples
- Lack of inspections on official controls over hunting grounds (all counties)

FUTURE CHALLENGES

- Continuous raising of knowledge on rabies as well as OVF importance
- Additional impute on passive surveillance samples (info publicly available, transferring knowledge during sampling or official controls of hunting grounds)
