#### BT outbreaks

 BTV-3 outbreaks occur still in the two Länder in the vicinity of the NL-DE border: Lower Saxony and North Rhine-Westphalia

- Up to 12 December 2023:
  - 24 outbreaks (red dots) and
  - one suspicion (yellow dot).




## BTV-zoning unchanged


# Without status free of BTV three Länder:


- Free Hanseatic City of Bremen
- North Rhine-Westphalia
- 3. Lower Saxony

All other **13 Länder**: status **free of BTV** 



## Epidemiological situation





Up to 12 December 2023

#### Conclusions

- Mostly only one animal positiv in an establishment.
- Supplementary movement requirements between free and not-free zones.
- Enhanced awareness and surveillance in the entire territory of Germany and in particularly in the BTV not-free zones and in the vicinity of those zones.
- Further spread of the disease in springtime expected.
